THIRD PARTY FUROSEMIDE (SALIX) ADMINISTRATION: Horsemen are reminded that third party administration of furosemide (Salix) is in effect at this race meet. Please refer to the 2018 NSA Spring Condition Book (center orange section) for complete details of the NSA Medication policy. Contact Dr. Nick Meittinis (410-365-4255). All Lasix horses must be treated by noon.

Foal papers are not required to be on file with the Horse Identifier at the races providing the horse can be properly identified, and tattoos/microchip are required for all horses, with a one-time exception providing the horse can be identified by his/her markings.

Attention: Horsemen must call J.W.Y. Martin Jr. 410-833-1167 by noon on Friday, April 27, 2018 to request stalls.

All entries must be at Worthington Farms barns and checked in with Stable Manager Jake Chalfin by 1:30 pm and remain until paddock call.

All scratches must be made no later than forty-five (45) minutes prior to post time for the Maryland Hunt Cup. Fines will be imposed.

There will be a Mandatory pre-race veterinary examination for all entries at 2:00 pm at the Worthington Farms barns by Drs. Rachel Westerlund and Cooper Williams. NSA protocol will be followed. NO BANDAGES of any kind will be permitted for this exam.

There will be an Officials meeting at the Steward's Tower at 3:00 pm.
There will be a mandatory riders meeting with the Stewards at the riders tent at 3:15 pm.

All entries shall tack at Worthington Farms.

Outriders and entries leave Worthington Farms barn for paddock at 3:20 pm. No lead ponies are allowed in the Paddock. All horses must be in paddock by 3:35 pm

As a convenience to Riders, the Stewards Advisory Committee has instructed the Clerks of Scales to account for a 2 lb allowance for the safety vest upon weighing out. Therefore, all Riders must weigh out at 2 lbs. over their assigned weight, with their safety vest.

Starting at 1:45 pm, there will be a shuttle for riders between the paddock and the Worthington Farms barn.

In keeping with the 122-years tradition of no commercial activity at our meet, the Maryland Hunt Cup will not permit any type of advertising on a rider or a horse running in this race.

Mr. & Mrs. J.W.Y. Martin Jr. invite all participants and officials to view the race video at Snow Hill following the running of the race. Please use driveway to reach house.

No dogs will be permitted on the Maryland Hunt Cup course on race day, nor will they be permitted in the stabling area at Worthington Farms. Please leave your dogs at home.

Traffic Pattern Alert: There will be NO through traffic on Tufton Avenue after 2:00 pm. General Parking must enter from the East via Falls Road/I-83. All Patron and Subscriber pass holders must access their lots from the West/ Greenspring Avenue side. At 3:00 pm the police will close all entrances to the course and Tufton Avenue.

NSA hang tags will admit cars to General Admission lot only. Additional passes must be obtained prior to race day. No sales will be made on race day. For ticket information go to: www.marylandhuntcup.com

Special Notes: There are two sections of the Paddock:

- 1) Horsemen Section - only Participating Horsemen and certain Officials will be allowed in this section. Wristbands will be provided to Participating Horsemen and those Officials.
- 2) Subscriber Section - holders of Paddock tickets, current NSA credentials and Press passes will be allowed in this section.

After all Riders are mounted, entries are to be led in numerical order out of the Paddock to the Finish line. The Post Parade will proceed from the Finish line, up the stretch and towards the last fence. There will be a gap prior to the last fence to exit the stretch.

The Maryland Hunt Cup race course was inspected by S. Gillet, Jr. on April 12, 2018.

The race is run over Fair Hunting Country.

Turf: The turf is very good on most of the course. The rest of the course should improve with good weather.

Smoothness: Most of the course is in good to very good shape.

Compaction: Ranges 60-100 (Yielding to Good) depending on elevation over 4 miles.

Moisture: Rating 6-10 (Average to Wet) depending on elevation.

Notes: Overall, the course is in good shape and will improve. A bucket of flags will be available race week at the first road crossing for course walkers to mark any issues.

UPDATE: Since the initial inspection, the overall course improved from good to very good. Additional rain is expected mid-week. A bucket of flags is at the first road crossing for course walkers to mark any issues. **We had a nice rain Tuesday night. The entire Maryland Hunt Cup course was aerated and Cambridge rolled prior to the rain.**
