Belmont Entries

Entries for the Belmont jump races to be run Thursday, September 20th are listed below in alphabetical order. The NYRA Racing office will draw the races tomorrow morning, Saturday, September 15th and the overnight will be available on the NYRA website tomorrow afternoon.

High Hope Course Report

The High Hope Steeplechase racecourse was inspected on September 7 by Mick Costello and Hill Parker.

Turf: The turf consists of bluegrass, fescue, perennial rye and there is excellent coverage.

Smoothness: The course has been consistently mowed, aerated and seeded.

Moisture: 40-10 (Average Dry to Wet) Samples taken in a number of areas.

Compaction: 120 (Good)

Notes: The course has been maintained, seeded and regularly mowed. It has been closed to any traffic since our last meet in May, 2017. There is strong growth due to the amount of rain in this area. All crossings will be mulched.

Shawan Downs Invitational Trials

SOTA and The Temple Gwathmey Steeplechase Foundation will sponsor the third Trials at Shawan Downs on Sunday, September 30th beginning at noon. There will be three Thoroughbred flat races carded for Juniors, NSA licensed Amateur Apprentice Jockeys, and horses which have previously started in a NSA sanctioned steeplechase race. Further conditions will be released next week. Entries, entry fees (\$100 per entry), and rider releases will be taken through the Shawan Downs website starting September 24th.

Temple Gwathmey Steeplechase Foundation Flat Race Bonus

In an effort to give amateur/apprentice jockeys more experience, the Temple Gwathmey Steeplechase Foundation will pay a \$500 bonus to the owner and trainer of any horse winning an NSA **flat** race this fall that is ridden by an amateur/apprentice jockey, in addition to any bonus already advertised.

Substitute Race – Foxfield (Training Flat)

For Three Year Olds and Upward. Three-year-olds, 145 lbs.; older, 150 lbs. Maidens allowed 5 lbs. **Jump riders are eligible for applicable jump apprentice allowances.** Entry fee \$50. The result of this race does not count toward a horse's official record. A \$500 award to the owner and the trainer of the winner to be paid by the race meet.

These races will be started by NYRA Starter, Mike McMullen.

All owners, trainers and riders must be licensed by the New York State Gaming Commission. All trainers must show evidence of Workmen's Compensation Insurance valid in the State of New York.

Owners, trainers, and riders are reminded to have their NSA Horsemen's Pin and/or NYRA badge for admission. NYRA no longer permits will calls.

Shoe Rule: Queen's Plate or Queen's Plate XT only.

Note: The final two fences in the stretch of each stakes race at Belmont Park will not be jumped. There will be nine (9) fences in the 2-1/4 mile William Entenmann Novice stakes, and ten (10) in The Lonesome Glory stakes.

NEW YORK STATE GAMING COMMISSION RULES WILL BE IN EFFECT FOR THE ADMINISTRATION OF LASIX.

All jockeys are subject to a breathalyzer test on race day monitored by New York State Gaming Commission officials.

All jump riders must ride at Belmont Park in a helmet approved by the NSA and use a ProCush Whip. JOCKEYS MAY NOT WEAR ADVERTISING ON THEIR BRITCHES. Purses distributed by the NSA as follows: 60% to first; 18% to second; 10% to third; 5% to fourth; 4% to fifth and 3% to sixth.

In all steeplechase races at Belmont Park, owners, whose horses earn a portion of the purse, will be billed the standard NSA entry fee equivalent to 2% of the purse in each race. In addition to NSA fees, 5% of any purse money earned in the William Entenmann Novice Stakes will be deducted as a fee to the Sport of Kings Bonus Fund. "Runners reward" applies, with all fees waived, for any horse which runs and does not earn a portion of the purse. In addition, all owners and trainers are required to pay an assessment to the New York Injured Jockey Compensation Fund. The charge is \$150 per start for the first ten starts, for a maximum of \$1,500 per year, plus 0.95% of all earned purse money. In addition, New York State statutory fees of 1% for the backstretch pension fund plus 2% to NYTHA will be deducted from any purse earnings at Saratoga. In addition, there is a \$25 Lasix fee for all horses that are administered Lasix and a \$5 start fee to be paid to the Thoroughbred Aftercare Alliance fund for all horses that run.
