The Aiken race course was inspected on October 9, 2018 by Anne and Bill Pezzano.

Turf: Bermuda, Winter Wheat, Winter Rye

Smoothness: There are some length wise tire tracks from vehicular traffic during the horse shows.

Compaction: 83.6 (good)

Moisture: 6.28 (average)

Notes: Course was aerated late July, drill seeded winter wheat September 19th, and broadcast rye October 5th. Fire ants are still a problem. Course was treated all over September 25th and spot treated October 5th. Army worms came this year, through spraying October 1st has solved the problem and the course is coming back. We are irrigating every night and heavy rains are in the forecast. The tire tracks will be rolled until they are as smooth as possible.
