ALL HORSES MUST BE ON THE GROUNDS BY 10:30AM REGARDLESS OF LASIX TIME

If your horse's Lasix time is earlier than 10:30am, it must be on the grounds 4 hours prior to post time of their scheduled race.

THIRD PARTY FUROSEMIDE (SALIX) ADMINISTRATION: Horsemen are reminded that third party administration of furosemide is in effect at this race meet. See Schedule. If your horse(s) have not previously run on Lasix, a NJRC declaration form MUST BE SUBMITTED PRIOR TO ENTRY. These forms can be faxed to 732-462-9894.

If you have ANY question about whether your horse is eligible to run on Lasix, please call the NJRC Lasix verifier, Debbie George @ 732-513-9942. When entering your horses, please inform the entry clerk if the horse will be running on Lasix so it will be included on the overnight. Lasix administration will be conducted by Dr. Celeste Kunz. She can be reached at 908-875-5057. Minimum Lasix dose is 3cc, maximum dose is 10cc.

ALL HORSES MUST BE TATTOOED or MICROCHIPPED with the approval of the Stewards.

No raised toes, front or rear, will be permitted in any race. A raised toe is defined as an extension of the shoe by more than 1/16 of an inch. Stickers, caulks and turndowns are not permitted. Shoes will be inspected before each race.

NEW THIS YEAR: All horses will be saddled in the Stable Saddling Tent. All saddle cloths will be distributed at the time of saddling on a race by race basis. You will not be able to pick up your saddle cloths in advance, as in the past. Grooms will also pick up their number pinneys at this time.

ALL HORSES MUST BE SADDLED AT THE STABLE SADDLING TENT IN THE STALL NUMBER CORRESPONDING TO THEIR SADDLECLOTH NUMBER.; ASSEMBLE IN NUMERICAL ORDER IN THE STABLE SADDLING AREA PADDOCK PRIOR TO EACH RACE AND PROCEED TO THE TOWER PADDOCK AS A GROUP. TRAINERS MUST ADHERE TO THE SCHEDULE THAT WILL BE POSTED IN THE BARN AREA.

All vans arriving Friday, Oct. 19 must use Gate 2 off Route 202. Security will continuously check.Gate for late arrivals.

After the last race there will be a reception for all owners, trainers, riders, officials, and their guests in the Chairman's Pavilion located adjacent to the paddock.

The Far Hills race course was inspected by Dean Torsilieri on October 5, 2018.

Turf: The entire turf course at Moorland Farm was aerated, slice seeded, and sand top dressed immediately after the Far Hills Race Meeting Association's Fall 2017 meet. Spring 2018 operations included divot repair, fertilization, rolling and aeration. Weekly mowing, weed control, and an aggressive IPM program have continued to keep the quality and consistency of the turf at the highest possible level. The turf is thick, lush, and has a clipped top out height of 6-8'. There are a few thin areas in parts of the timber course close to the tree line on the backstretch. Ongoing weed control for this part of the course is in place.

Smoothness: The course has been rolled, aerated, and hand walked with root zone mix to fill any divots or cupping. The surface is smooth and consistent with a giving yet firm resiliency. There is NO vehicular traffic allowed on the course at any time.

Compaction: Readings taken with a Lang Penetrometer put the turf course at a reading of 50-70 (yielding)

Moisture: 8-10 (average to Average wet)

Notes: Due to the amount of rainfall there are a few areas of weak turf areas on the outside edge of the course next to the patrol judge lane. There are no compromised areas on any of the actual courses.

### Directions:

From Route 78: Take Exit 29 to Route 287 North to Exit 22B (Route 202/206 North). Bear right at Route 202 North and proceed to Gate #2.

From Bernardsville via Route 202 South: At railroad tracks in Far Hills, turn left onto Liberty Corner Road (county #512) to Gate #4 or Gate #5.

From the South via Route 287: Take Exit 22B. Turn right onto Route 202/206 North. Bear right onto Route 202 North and proceed to Gate #2.

From the North via Route 287: Take Exit 22 to Route 202/206 North. Bear right onto Route 202 North and proceed to Gate #2.

From Chester/Peapack Area via Route 206 South: Turn left onto Pottersville Road (County #512) to Main Street in Gladstone. Turn right onto Main Street in Gladstone (still County #512). Follow into Far Hills. Turn left onto Route 202 North and proceed to Gate #2.

From Basking Ridge & Liberty Corner via Liberty Corner Road (County #512): Proceed North on Liberty Corner Road (County #512), turn left and proceed to Gate #4 or Gate #5.

### Far Hills Licensing – New Jersey Racing Commission

All Owners, Trainers, Assistant Trainers and Jockeys participating in the Far Hills Race Meeting are required to be licensed by the New Jersey Racing Commission (NJRC). The easiest way to obtain a license is by going to the Commission's website (<https://www.nj.gov/oag/racing/>) and click on "Licensing Forms" on the left-hand side.

Please complete your forms in advance of your arrival at Far Hills. This will expedite the process on race day. The final phase of the licensing process will be completed Saturday morning on the grounds. NJRC will have a licensing tent located in the barn area. The licensing area will be staffed by 8:30 a.m.

Grooms that are licensed in another racing jurisdiction will be granted reciprocity, as long as they bring proof of a current license.

Horsemen that ran at Monmouth Park in August should already be licensed.

People applying for licensure need cash (\$132.25) or 2 checks (\$82.25 and \$50). The first check is for \$82.25 which is the cost of fingerprinting. The second check is for \$50 which is the cost of the license fee. Checks made payable to the New Jersey Racing Commission. Credit Cards are **NOT** accepted.
