IMPORTANT NOTICE: There will be a mandatory pre-race veterinary exam at the on-site stabling area from 8:00 to 9:00 a.m. Bandages are not permitted during the examination. This year temporary stabling will be located on site at racecourse (corner of Roots Tavern and Nations Road). Call Amanda Coney 585-760-9223 for information on stabling.

LASIX HORSES MUST BE ON THE GROUNDS 4 HOURS PRIOR TO POST TIME FOR THEIR SCHEDULED RACE. ALL HORSES MUST BE ON THE GROUNDS 2 HOURS PRIOR TO POST TIME FOR THE FIRST RACE UNLESS EXCUSED BY THE STEWARDS FOR EXTENUATING CIRCUMSTANCES.

THIRD PARTY FUROSEMIDE (SALIX) ADMINISTRATION: Horsemen are reminded that third party administration of furosemide (Salix) is in effect at this race meet. Please refer to the 2018 NSA Fall Condition Book (center green section) for complete details of the new NSA Medication policy. Contact Dr. Bonny Henderson (585-261-1372).

ATTENTION JOCKEYS: There will be a mandatory meeting of apprentice jockeys with the Stewards at 11:45 a.m. at the jockeys tent. There will be a mandatory meeting of all jockeys with the Stewards at 12:00 a.m. following the apprentice jockeys meeting at the jockeys tent.

There will be an Officials meeting at 12:15 p.m. at the Jockeys Tent.

There will be a \$100 award to the attendant of the best "turned out" horse in each race.

Foal papers are not required to be on file with the Horse Identifier at the races providing the horse can be properly identified; and tattoos are required for all horses, with a one-time exception providing the horse can be identified by markings. All scratches must be made no later than one hour prior to post time for the first race.

NSA Shoe Policy: No raised toes, front or rear, will be permitted in any race. A raised toe is defined as an extension of the shoe by more than 1/16 of an inch. Stickers, caulks and turndowns are not permitted.

The Genesee Valley race course was inspected on October 1, 2018 by Turner Boone.

Turf: Very thick measuring 6-8 inches

Smoothness: The course is very smooth this year, with no livestock allowed and ample mowing.

Compaction: 9 (good) Moisture: 6-8 (average-average wet)

Notes: We have plans to aerovate the landings of the jumps and the track between fences depending on the forecast. We have had regular rains after a dry summer making a lot of new growth and thick cover.
