ATTENTION JOCKEYS: There will be a mandatory meeting of apprentice jockeys with the Stewards at 11:15 a.m. at the jockeys' room. There will be a mandatory meeting of all jockeys with the Stewards at 11:30 a.m. following the apprentice jockeys' meeting at the jockeys' room. ALL RIDERS MUST ATTEND. All jockeys are reminded to check-in with the Clerk of Scales one hour prior to post time of the first race and report his/her engagement(s) and overweight, if any.

There will be an Official's Meeting at the Judge's Stand at 11:45 a.m. We are designating a FEW parking spaces behind the jockey's hut, but on the rail. Jockeys can enter with their NSA credentials, proceed BEHIND the Paddock, and look for the "J" on the rail, for those spots.

Trainers who would like to ship to the grounds on Friday in an effort to avoid traffic delays need to call ahead to Martha Strawther at the Montpelier office 540-672-0027. The gates to Montpelier will be locked unless previous arrangements have been made. We have installed temporary stalls so all horses will be guaranteed a stall. NO PONIES WILL BE ASSIGNED A STALL.

THIRD PARTY FUROSEMIDE (SALIX) ADMINISTRATION

Horsemen are reminded that third party administration of furosemide (Salix) is in effect at this race meet. Please refer to the 2018 NSA Fall Condition Book (center green section) for complete details of the new NSA Medication policy. Contact Dr. Nicole Swinehart (803-427-4053)

There will be a mandatory pre-race veterinarian exam with Dr. Reynolds Cowles. Bandages are not permitted during the examination. LASIX HORSES MUST BE ON THE GROUNDS 4 HOURS PRIOR TO POST TIME FOR THEIR SCHEDULED RACE. ALL HORSES MUST BE ON THE GROUNDS 2 HOURS PRIOR TO POST TIME FOR THE FIRST RACE UNLESS EXCUSED BY THE STEWARDS FOR EXTENUATING CIRCUMSTANCES.

The Virginia Department of Agriculture is requiring that all horses be accompanied by a negative Coggins conducted within the last 12 months and a valid Health Certificate for those coming out of state to gain access to the grounds of any meet run in Virginia.

WE PREFER THAT HORSES ASSEMBLE IN THE BARN AREA AND PROCEED TO THE PADDOCK IN SMALL GROUPS. Trainers have the option to saddle in the barn or Paddock (two new saddling stalls with high sides have been constructed in the Paddock).

NOTE TO HORSEMEN -- VERY IMPORTANT - Entrance to Montpelier for Horse Vans and Trailers ONLY which should eliminate having to deal with traffic for General Parking and pedestrians.

New Directions: From Orange and North: travel PAST the old entrance (Dolly Madison Road) and PAST the main entrance to Montpelier to the next road on the left, Route 639, Jacksontown Road, designated Gate #3, go left. Follow just 3/10 of mile to Y in road and bear left, watch for TAGG'S ISLAND ROAD sign on left and enter at marked entrance, will be manned. This entrance is for HORSE vans ONLY. Follow good gravel road past flat track stop to sign at Center Road, cross Center Road, (will have traffic director there) and take next left into race barn. Van entrance is marked with orange and yellow signs

From Charlottesville and South: You will come to Rt. 639, designated Gate #3 before other entrances to Montpelier, go right and follow directions above. (Brian Hogan recently drove this road and proclaimed it a good idea)

NSA HORSEMEN. (GATE 2 is the only entrance) If you are entering with NSA credentials please stop at the ticket takers at the entrances and get a VIP Parking Pass. This is complimentary but necessary to park in the Infield. If you do not stop you will be stopped inside. Unless involved in horse care, NSA horsemen running horses are encouraged to park on the Infield and proceed to the OTR tent in the Paddock. ONLY those NSA members running horses may park at the Barn as the parking there is very limited.

The Montpelier race course was inspected on October 18, 2018 by Bill Bichell and Brooke Royster.

Turf: Turf is consistently 6 inches long over the entire course. We anticipate an additional 2-3 inches of growth between now and race day. It is very thick, there are no bare patches and virtually no weeds and no clover.

Smoothness: Careful aeration over the entire growing season has made the course smoother and very consistent. It feels springy to the step.

Compaction: Compaction ranged from 8.5 to 10 (good), again very consistent over the entire course, higher or lower ground made little difference.

Moisture: Moisture ranged from 6 to 9.5 (average - wet), but most areas were in the 6-7 range (average ? average wet).

Notes: Thanks to careful maintenance and consistent rainfall over the entire growing season the course is in as good a shape as it has ever been. Overhanging nut trees have been trimmed back, and the few nuts on the edge of the course will be picked up by hand the day before the races.

IMPORTANT – Friday arrivals which have not been to Montpelier before need to secure specific directions from the race office. It is very difficult/stressful to find your way onto the property in the dark – especially with a horse van – so please call one of the contact people above prior to arrival time for this information. **FRIDAY ARRIVALS NOTE that we have new security procedures and you MUST call ahead as gates are locked early and new codes have been installed.**

Directions: (suggest following these directions - GPS tends to direct people from south via a bad back road) **From Washington, D.C.** – West on I-66 to US 29 South to third Culpeper Exit. South on Route 15 to Orange, VA, or take I-95 to Fredericksburg; west on Route 3 to Route 20 South to Orange. From downtown Orange take Route 20 W to Montpelier Station.

From Richmond – West on I-64 to Route 15 North to Orange, VA. From downtown Orange take Route 20 South to Montpelier Station.

From Charlottesville – East on Route 20 to Montpelier Station, or US 29 North to State Route 33 East to Route 20 East to Montpelier Station.

Owners and Trainers arriving without a horse van **should NOT follow horse van directions.**

Enter **Gate #2** and show NSA credentials you will be given a VIP parking pass. Parking at the barn area is extremely limited and **discouraged** except for trainers and jockeys. **Jockeys:** there is some designated parking for jockeys on the Paddock Rail behind the Jockeys Hut, do NOT park in numbered spaces or towing will result.

At Montpelier Station - Horse Vans follow signs towards GATE #3 on Route 20 (furthest from Orange) Route 639 then follow HORSE VAN signs to new gravel road that runs on the back of the property, crosses Center Road to left turn to Barn. Will be marked with signs. Others follow directions on parking pass. Parking in undesignated areas may result in towing.
