THIRD PARTY FUROSEMIDE (SALIX) ADMINISTRATION

Horsemen are reminded that third party administration of furosemide (Salix) is in effect at this race meet. Please refer to the 2018 NSA Fall Condition Book (center green section) for complete details of the NSA Medication policy. Contact Dr. Taryn Gassert 610-207-9209).

Foal papers are not required to be on file with the Horse Identifier at the races providing the horse can be properly identified; and tattoos or microchips are required for all horses, with a one-time exception providing the horse can be identified by its markings. All scratches must be made no later than one hour prior to post time for the first race.

All horses will be saddled in the stable area.

COURSE UPDATE ? OCTOBER 30, 2018: Following a final inspection of the Pennsylvania Hunt Cup course, the Stewards, along with Race Chairmen Anne and Michael Moran, have deemed the outer course for the Pennsylvania Hunt Cup unfit for racing. The Pennsylvania Hunt Cup will now be run over a modified 4-mile course jumping 18 fences. Please contact race meet officials if you have any further questions regarding this change.

The Pennsylvania Hunt Cup race course was inspected on October 22, 2018 by John Hodges and Jorge Palucious.

Turf: The race is run over fair hunting ground with rolling hills. Turf is mostly fescue 4 to 6 inches in length.

Smoothness: The Moran side of the course is quite smooth. The Weymouth side is a bit rougher due to accessibility. Both sides have been rolled recently. The Moran side was decompacted in September.

Compaction: On a 1 to 20 scale with 20 being the hardest, the high ground is 10 (good); mid ground 8 (yielding); and the lowest ground is 5-6 (yielding)

Moisture: On a 1-10 scale with 10 being the wettest, high ground is 4-6 (average dry-dry), lower ground is 6-8 (average-average wet), lowest lying areas 8-10 (average wet-wet)

Notes: After a record rainfall this summer, the ground is totally saturated and there are still pockets of standing water on the Weymouth property. The rest of the course is draining off but the low-lying areas are holding moisture. There is an inspection with Steward Gus Brown this afternoon to determine whether we can run the Pennsylvania Hunt Cup over Weymouth?s or alter the course to more favorable ground. Stay tuned ? all other races will be run as usual.

From West Chester, PA – Route 202 South to Route 926 (Street Road) West. Follow Route 926 across Route 82 and continue to intersection of Newark Road. For **Gate #1**: Turn right onto Newark Road and go 1/4 mile to entrance on left. For **Gate #2**: Stay on Route 926 West approximately 1/4 mile to entrance on right.

From New Jersey or New York – NJ Turnpike to Route 295 South. Cross Commodore Barry Bridge and follow I-95 South to Route 322 West. to Route 1 South and follow to Toughkenamon Exit. Turn right (North) onto Newark Road for 3-4 miles to intersection of Route 926 (Street Road). Follow directions above for appropriate gate.

From Maryland – I-95 North to Exit 93 (Port Deposit). Follow Route 275 North to Route 276 North to Route 1. Follow Route 1 North to Toughkenamon Exit. Turn left (North) onto Newark Road and follow 3-4 miles to intersection of Route 926 (Street Road). Follow directions above for appropriate gate.

From Delaware – Route 52 North to Route 1. Left (South) on Route 1 to Toughkenamon Exit. Turn right (North) onto Newark Road and follow 3-4 miles to intersection of Route 926 (Street Road). Follow directions above for appropriate gate.

From Lancaster – Route 41 South to Route 926 East (Street Road) and follow 5-6 miles. Gate #2 will be on the right. Continue past Gate #2 to stop sign and turn left onto Newark road and follow directions above for Gates #1 and #3.

From Harrisburg – Pennsylvania Turnpike to Downingtown Exit. Take Route 202 South to Route 1. Turn right (South) on Route 1 to the Toughkenamon Exit.
