Attention Jockeys: There will be a mandatory meeting between the Stewards and all jockeys at 11:45 p.m. at the jockeys' tent. ALL RIDERS MUST ATTEND. All jockeys are reminded to check-in with the Clerk of Scales one hour prior to post time of the first race and report his/her engagement(s) and overweight, if any.

There will be an officials' meeting at 12:00 p.m. following the jockeys meeting at the Stewards Stand.

SHOWERS WILL BE AVAILABLE ON RACE DAY, PLEASE PROVIDE YOUR OWN TOWEL.

There will be a mandatory pre-race vet check with Dr. Chris Ernst. Bandages are not permitted during the examination. LASIX HORSES MUST BE ON THE GROUNDS 4 HOURS PRIOR TO POST TIME FOR THEIR SCHEDULED RACE. ALL HORSES MUST BE ON THE GROUNDS 2 HOURS PRIOR TO POST TIME FOR THE FIRST RACE UNLESS EXCUSED BY THE STEWARDS FOR EXTENUATING CIRCUMSTANCES.

THIRD PARTY FUROSEMIDE (SALIX) ADMINISTRATION: Horsemen are reminded that third party administration of furosemide (Salix) is in effect at this race meet. Please refer to the 2018 NSA Fall Condition Book (center green section) for complete details of the NSA Medication policy. Contact Dr. Jeff Witwer (803-243-0328).

Attention Horsemen: All scratches must be made no later than one hour prior to post time for the first race.

REMINDER: Foal papers are not required to be on file with the Horse Identifier at the races in claiming races providing the horse can be properly identified; and tattoos or microchips are required for all horses.

Attention Trainers: By order of the South Carolina State Veterinarian, all racehorses, ponies, donkeys and any other horses entering the Steeplechase of Charleston must have the following documents: Requirements for out of state horses: 1. CVI - Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (valid for 30 days) including description, date of negative EIA (Coggins) results, Lab and Accession number; and 2. Negative EIA (Coggins) test within 12 months Requirements for in-state (South Carolina) horses: 1. Negative EIA (Coggins) test within 12 months These documents may be checked by State Inspectors on race day.

RACE DAY TRAFFIC: Heavy traffic is to be expected on race day, please be advised to new traffic pattern and parking. PLEASE PARK IN LOT A ONLY. Due to revised traffic patters, NO CARS will be allowed in stable area.

OTR CREDENTIALS: Please pick up race day credentials at the GATE 2 TICKET KIOSK and then continue on to the entrance of the OTR Tent.

There will be a \$100 award for the best turned out horse in each race sponsored by Austin Walker and Toby Edwards.

The Charleston race course report was updated on November 5, 2018 by Toby Edwards.

Turf: Turf consists of a mixture of semi-dormant Bermuda and broadcast seeded rye grass that averages 5-6' in height. Mowing will be done before race day if necessary.

Smoothness: The course has been fertilized, aerated and harrowed a number of times during the year and is smooth throughout.

Compaction: 90-100 (good)

Moisture: 8-10

Notes: Overall the course is in great shape. We will core aerate again before race day if necessary to keep the compaction rate below 110 (good).

UPDATE: We received 1.5 inches of rain last night and more is expected on Wednesday. It is a well draining race course and conditions are expected to be perfect on race day.
