Horses in Training List

All NSA trainers are **required** to submit a "Horses in Training" list for the spring of 2019. For your convenience, a form is below which should be filled out and emailed to courtneyreid@nationalsteeplechase.com. Horses entered that are **not** on a "Horses in Training" list will be least preferred in any race which overfills.

Ratings

The first ratings list for 2019 will be published when all Horses in Training lists are submitted.

NSA New Waiver Claimer Policy

At the time of entry into any NSA steeplechase claiming race, the trainer may declare a horse ineligible to be claimed provided:

1. The horse has been laid off and has not started for a minimum of 120 calendar days since its last race; **and**
2. The horse is entered for a claiming price equal to or greater than the price at which it last started over jumps.
