ATTENTION JOCKEYS: There will be a mandatory meeting of all jockeys with the Stewards at 12:00 p.m. at the jockeys tent. ALL RIDERS MUST ATTEND AND WILL BE FINED FOR BEING LATE. All jockeys are reminded to check-in with the Clerk of Scales one hour prior to post time for the first race and report his/her engagement(s) and overweight, if any.

There will be an Officials Meeting at 12:15 p.m. at the Stewards Stand.  
There will be a mandatory pre-race vet check with Dr. Lisa Handy. Bandages are not permitted during the examination. LASIX HORSES MUST BE ON THE GROUNDS 4 HOURS PRIOR TO POST TIME FOR THEIR SCHEDULED RACE. ALL HORSES MUST BE ON THE GROUNDS 2 HOURS PRIOR TO POST TIME FOR THE FIRST RACE UNLESS EXCUSED BY THE STEWARDS FOR EXTENUATING CIRCUMSTANCES. Horsemen are reminded that third party administration of furosemide (Salix) is in effect at this race meet. Turf: Drilled field rye and Broadcast rye grass.

Smoothness: There are some uneven areas due to horse show traffic which will be addressed.

Compaction: 96.29 (Good)

Moisture: 3.8 (Average Dry)

Notes: The rye has done well over the winter and the turf is thick and lush. Repairs to the road crossings are underway. The course will be rolled again to improve smoothness.
