Official Actions:

The course walk took place on Monday, April 8th with Ross Pearce, & Jack Fisher, and Bob Kinsley.

First Race: AQUIES was randomly selected for pre race 'milkshake' testing. The trainers of GRAND MANAN and LEMONY BAY requested that their riders be allowed to mount outside the paddock. Permission granted. GRAND MANAN pulled up before the 14th fence. Rider Baumgardner reported that the horse 'did not like the going.' DOC CEBU lost rider Hadden Frost at the last fence when he made a jumping error. Frost was cleared by the course physician. After the race Eric Poretz, the rider of WITOR who finished second, claimed foul against the winner, MYSTIC STRIKE, ridden by Mark Beecher for alleged interference around the turn after fence #7 and again on the turn along Pocock Rd. The claim was disallowed.

Second Race: After the pre-race exam, the examining vets recommended that ENUFF ALEX be scratched. The horse was scratched and is therefore now on the Vet's List.

Third Race: ROMANCING pulled up before the 14th fence ('tired').

Fourth Race: CLASS INDIAN and SUMO POWER both pulled up before the 15th fence. Both were reported to have tired.

Official Comments:

Management did an amazing job of coping with the eruption of several new springs on the course due to the excessive rainfall of the last few months. Due to their efforts and a few minor adjustments to the course, the races were able to be run as scheduled without jeopardizing safety.
