Attention Jockeys: There will be a mandatory meeting between the Stewards and all jockeys at 11:30 a.m. at the jockeys' tent. There will be an officials' meeting at 11:45 a.m. following the jockeys meeting, at the Stewards Stand.

There will be a mandatory pre-race veterinarian exam with Dr. Reynolds Cowles. Bandages are not permitted during the examination. ALL HORSES MUST BE ON THE GROUNDS 2 HOURS PRIOR TO POST TIME FOR THE FIRST RACE (IF NOT ON LASIX) FOR THE PRE-RACE VET CHECK UNLESS EXCUSED BY THE STEWARDS FOR EXTENUATING CIRCUMSTANCES. LASIX HORSES MUST BE ON THE GROUNDS 4 HOURS PRIOR TO POST TIME FOR THEIR SCHEDULED RACE.

THIRD PARTY FUROSEMIDE (SALIX) ADMINISTRATION

Horsemen are reminded that third party administration of furosemide (Salix) is in effect at this race meet. Please refer to the 2019 NSA Spring Condition Book (center pink section) for complete details of the NSA Medication policy. Contact Dr. Jeff Witwer (803-243-0328).

Foal papers are not required to be on file with the Horse Identifier at the races providing the horse can be properly identified; and tattoos and/or microchips are required for all horses, with a one-time exception providing the horse can be identified by its markings. All scratches must be made no later than one hour prior to post time for the first race.

As required by the Virginia Department of Agriculture: All horses (including horses originating within Virginia) entering Foxfield Races must have an official health certificate dated within 30 days of entry and signed by a licensed veterinarian. This document must contain the following statement: "Horses represented on this certificate have not originated from a barn with a confirmed or suspected case of Equine Herpes Virus or Strangles, have not shown signs suggestive of these diseases, and have not been febrile within the previous three weeks". Rectal temperature for each horse at the time of examination must be recorded on the health certificate. Coggins test must be conducted within 12 months, and the test report must be presented with the health certificate. The test must be valid to cover the time the horse is expected to be within the facility.

All owners, trainers, and riders should enter at the East Gate (the gate closest to Charlottesville). We will be following a new procedure this year because of the problem with counterfeit tickets. All OTR's must have the proper credentials and hang tags. Credentials will be located at the barn area in the hands of Brian Barquin. They will receive an OTR ribbon which will give them access to the tower area. They will also receive a parking hang tag with the directions to the parking spot. Horsemen should use alternate routes rather than Garth Road to avoid being stuck in traffic! All horsemen are invited to lunch at the tower beginning at 11:00 a.m.

Following the races the road will be closed to through traffic. Those people who exit from the East Gate must turn right and travel toward Charlottesville.

The Foxfield Spring race course was inspected by Thomas Shifflett on April 15, 2019.

Turf: The turf is at a height of 2 to 3.5 inches but not consistent due to irregular temperatures at night. There is supposed to be a warming trend this week which will increase growth.

Smoothness: The course is fairly smooth. There was a lot of traffic last fall over the flat track. Following the fall race, the course was dragged, aerated, rolled and seeded.

Compaction: Between 10 and 12 (good)

Moisture: The course is wet. We had almost two inches of rain on April 14.

Notes: The two areas that were damaged by last summer's heavy rains have recovered nicely and are in good condition.

Directions:

From the North (Washington D.C.): Take Route 29 South to 250 By-Pass West exit (Lynchburg). Get off at 1st exit (Barracks Road – Rt. 654), turn right and Foxfield is 4 miles on the left.

From the South (Lynchburg): Take Route 29 North to Barracks Road exit (Rt. 654), turn left, Foxfield is 4 miles on left.

From the East (Richmond): Take I-64 West to Shadwell (Exit 124), turn right and go 4.7 miles to Barracks Road exit (Rt. 654), turn right, Foxfield is 4 miles on left.

From the West (Waynesboro): Take I-64 East to 29 North (Exit 118-B), go 3.2 miles to Barracks Road exit (Rt. 654), turn left, Foxfield is 4 miles on left.

Avoiding Barracks Road traffic: Traveling 29 South from the Warrenton/Culpepper area, approximately 10 miles north of Charlottesville look for signs to the Charlottesville/Albemarle Airport. There is a traffic light and a car dealership called Airport Auto. This is Route 649, turn right. Go 7/10 of a mile and bear left at the airport. Go 1 mile to intersection at end of runway and bear left to stop sign. This is Route 743, turn left. Go 3 miles to bridge. Cross bridge and turn right onto Route 676 (watch for bad curves). Go 4.2 miles to end of road and turn left onto Route 601. Go 9/10 of a mile to end of road at the store and turn left. Foxfield will be on the right. Follow traffic officers and signs to East Gate.
