**IMPORTANT:** No cars to park in van area. All cars are to park in designated owner trainer rider parking only. If cars are parked in the Van parking area they will be towed out immediately.

**ALL HORSES WILL BE SADDLED IN THE BARN BEFORE EVERY RACE. THERE WILL BE NO SADDLING IN THE PADDOCK.**

Foal papers are no longer required to be on file with the Horse Identifier at the races in claiming races providing the horse can be properly identified; and tattoo and/or microchip is required for all horses, with a one-time exception providing the horse can be identified by its markings.

All scratches must be made no later than one hour prior to post time for the first race.

Horsemen: As required by the Virginia Department of Agriculture: "All horses must be accompanied by a report of an official negative test for equine infectious anemia (Coggins Test) conducted within the last 12 months. The Certificate must accompany all horses in order to gain access to the races. This requirement will be strictly enforced. Please turn in a copy of your Coggins test to the HORSE IDENTIFIER (Brian Jarvis).

**HORSEMEN PARKING:** Parking for Owners/Trainers/Riders: Come in to van area and follow signs to new parking area.

A luncheon and cocktail party will be available for the participants of today's races (owners, trainers and riders) in the Official Luncheon Tent located near the stables and paddock.

NSA badges must be **VISIBLE** to expedite you through the Reserved Enclosure Gate. Owners, Trainers and riders - there are Member boxes available for your viewing of the races located on the top in front of the tents.
