Horsemen are reminded that third party administration of furosemide (Salix) is in effect at this race meet. Please refer to the 2019 NSA Spring Condition Book (center pink section) for complete details of the NSA Medication policy. There will be a pre-race veterinary exam performed by Dr. Matt Storey beginning at 10:30 a.m. in the barn area. Bandages are not permitted during the examination. LASIX HORSES MUST BE ON THE GROUNDS 4 HOURS PRIOR TO POST TIME FOR THEIR SCHEDULED RACE. ALL HORSES MUST BE ON THE GROUNDS 2 HOURS PRIOR TO POST TIME FOR THE FIRST RACE UNLESS EXCUSED BY THE STEWARDS FOR EXTENUATING CIRCUMSTANCES.

Horsemen are reminded to bring a copy of their horse(s) Coggins test to the races.

Foal papers are no longer be required to be on file with the Horse Identifier at the races providing the horse can be properly identified; and tattoos and/or microchips are required for all horses, with a one-time exception providing the horse can be identified by its markings.

RACE DAY ARRIVAL:

- ENTER THROUGH GATE 3: (Potters Road) Horsemen must display their 2017 NSA hang tag and NSA OTR pins.

- HORSEMEN'S CHECK-IN TENT:

- HORSEMEN'S CREDENTIALS: may be obtained at the Horsemen's Check-in Tent (it's well marked).

- ACCESS TO MEMBER'S HILL & STABLE AREA: Obtain Queen's Cup issued Horsemen's Badges to gain access to Stable area and Member's Hill

REMINDER: NSA OTRs MUST enter the front entrance of the Eldridge Club to exchange their meal ticket for a wristband. Thereafter, OTR's may egress through the rear entrance as long as the wristband and Horsemen's Badge is displayed.

IMPORTANT NOTICE: At the request of SOTA, only those with Queen's Cup Horsemen's Badges will be allowed in the stable area. Please do not give our Queen's Cup STAFF a hard time if you do not have your Queen's Cup Horsemen's Badge and are wishing access to the Stabling area.

Course Update:

The Brooklandwood racecourse was re-inspected Monday, April 22, 2019 at 0830 by Bill Price, co-race chair.

Turf: Consistent, thick and lush throughout. The Brooklandwood Racecourse turf is made-up of a blend of fine turf fescues, bluegrass & perennial rye grasses. Turf is currently at a height of 5 inches.

The course was fertilized by Race Partner, TruGreen on March 22 with high levels of nitrogen to promote top growth and fast green-up. Dry nitrogen will be spread by TruGreen this coming Wednesday, April 17. Thin areas of note: Turf is quite thick throughout on the backside but there are some areas of poa annua which is quickly dying off. This area is on the approach to H2 as well as in the center of the course between H5 and Steeplethon fence 5 on the finishing stretch. The bottom tie wall on Member's Hill was replaced with a permanent concrete segmental wall system in 2017 affecting the outer areas of the racecourse below Member's Hill. The grass is thin along this area and is improving but is not in the running area of the racecourse. None of the aforementioned characteristics should be cause for concern as they are cosmetic in nature. Again, these areas are not part of the racing areas of the racecourse. We finally had some relief from the rain with warm drying winds Monday (15) - Friday (19). We had showers Saturday (19) morning into Sunday (20).

Smoothness: Smooth. Very smooth throughout. A good feel under foot.

Compaction: AVG 100-120 (good). The racecourse was tine aerated using the ?Aerway? March 4 and again April 14. The racecourse will be aerated again on the racing lanes only, Monday 22. Irrigation will be used only if necessary.

Moisture: 8 (average wet). The irrigation was used sparingly in late March but none to date the month of April. Mother Nature is providing an overabundance of moisture, which should set-up the racecourse perfectly for Saturday, April 27th. If the rain showers persist as predicted the latter part of the week, expected ?going? race day should be listed as ?GOOD throughout (SOFT in areas)?.

Notes: Weather Forecast: No rain is expected through Thursday (25). 60% chance of rain Friday afternoon. Saturday (race day) is expected to be mostly sunny, highs in the upper 70s -low 80s Stables and finish Line hydration: Large floor fans will be set-up in the entrances to the stable area. Ice machine and endless amounts of water (cold and hot) will be available in the stable area.
