Officials are to enter Gate 5 off Route 52 and must display their 2019 NSA hangtag or their Winterthur-issued hangtag. If you do not have proper credentials, you must call Jill Abbott prior to race day at 302-218-7529.

THIRD PARTY FUROSEMIDE (SALIX) ADMINISTRATION

Horsemen are reminded that third party administration of furosemide (Salix) is in effect at this race meet. Please refer to the 2019 NSA Spring Condition Book (center pink section) for complete details of the NSA Medication policy. Contact Dr. Jeff Witwer (803-243-0328)

Foal papers are not required to be on file with the Horse Identifier. Tattoos or microchips are required for all horses, with a one-time exception providing the horse can be identified by his/her markings.

Attention Horsemen: All scratches must be made no later than one hour prior to post time for the first race.

There will be a mandatory pre-race veterinary examination conducted by Dr. Charles Arensberg. LASIX HORSES MUST BE ON THE GROUNDS 4 HOURS PRIOR TO POST TIME FOR THEIR SCHEDULED RACE. ALL HORSES MUST BE ON THE GROUNDS 2 HOURS PRIOR TO POST TIME FOR THE FIRST RACE UNLESS EXCUSED BY THE STEWARDS FOR EXTENUATING CIRCUMSTANCES.

ALL HORSES WILL BE SADDLED IN THE STABLE AREA BEFORE EVERY RACE AND PROCEED TO THE PADDOCK AS A GROUP. THERE WILL BE NO SADDLING IN THE PADDOCK.

Credentials Needed: 2019 NSA Horsemen lapel pins and NSA Hang tag mandatory. MUST ENTER OFF RT. 52/KENNETT PIKE at GATE 5 with NSA hangtag visible on rearview mirror.

We recommend arriving prior to 11:30 because of traffic on Route 52.

For your convenience and enjoyment, a video screen will again be provided in the Horseman Hospitality Lunch Tent televising the races and day long activities.

Owners, trainers, and riders are invited to lunch in the Horsemen Hospitality tent located near the Stewards Tower. NSA pin must be worn for admission. Any guests must have proper WINTERTHUR wristband credentials and may be purchased pre-race by calling Jill Abbott at 302.218.7529. Other various food concessions available on site for purchase.

The Winterthur race course was inspected on April 20, 2019 by Rob Plankinton.

Turf: The turf on this course consists of a relatively thick, lush cover of native fescue and "Division One", a mixture of turf fescues, blues, and rye grass that averaged 6" in height and is consistent.

Fertilized in the spring, aerated in the fall and spring, rolled in spring, seeded in spring.

Smoothness: This course has been rolled two times (Fall and Spring) and the ground is relatively smooth throughout.

Compaction: 80 (yielding). Grass cover provides good cushion.

Moisture: 8.6 (average wet-wet)

Notes: Eight traditional "stake and bound" timber fences with telephone pole ground base rails serve as the timber course. The 1st fence is five panels wide and the remaining seven fences are four panels wide. At least two of the fences offer only one option for "run around room". However, this concern has not caused any problems in the past.

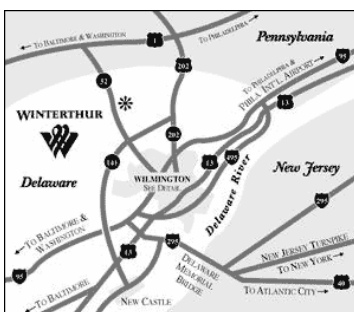

Travel times:

From Philadelphia: 45 minutes

From Philadelphia/New Jersey:

If traveling over the Commodore Barry Bridge:

- Take 95 South to Wilmington; take exit 7B, which is Delaware Avenue/Rte. 52
- At end of exit ramp, turn right at light to head NW out of town
- As soon as possible, move into left-most lane because road splits; stay on Rte. 52 North
- Winterthur is on Rte. 52, six miles NW of Wilmington

If traveling over the Delaware Memorial Bridge:

- After crossing Delaware Memorial Bridge, follow 95 North to Wilmington
- Take exit 7, which is Delaware Avenue/Rte. 52
- Travel three blocks to Rte. 52; take a left at light
- Stay in left-most lane to stay on Rte. 52 North
- Winterthur is on Rte. 52, six miles NW of Wilmington

From I-476 (the Blue Route):

- Take the Blue Route to I-95 South to Wilmington
- Follow directions from Philadelphia.

From Baltimore/Washington:

- Take 95 North to Wilmington; take exit 7, which is Delaware Avenue/Rte. 52
- Travel three blocks to Rte. 52; take a left at light
- Stay in left-most lane to stay on Rte. 52 North
- Winterthur is on Rte. 52, six miles NW of Wilmington
