ATTENTION: Due to an impending New Jersey state government shutdown that could take place on July 1, all owners, trainers, and riders must be licensed with the New Jersey Racing Commission by Sunday, June 30. Anyone not licensed by that time will not be allowed to participate.

New Jersey Racing Commission: (609) 292-0613

The race is sanctioned and under the rules and regulations of the New Jersey Racing Commission. All Owners, Trainers and Riders must be licensed with the New Jersey Racing Commission. Licenses must be paid with a check or credit card (no cash). A Worker's Compensation policy for all trainers must be on file with the New Jersey Racing Commission.

ALL Horses Shipping in to Race MUST be in their Assigned Stalls for Veterinarian Check by 11:00 AM

Lasix Policy

Trainers must hang a "HORSE IN TODAY" sign on stall doors by 7:00 AM. Ship-ins MUST go to the receiving barn or a "prior approved" stall. If you are not going to ship in to your assigned stall, you must give 24 hour notice to the stall office. (Failure to do so will result in a fine). All horses must be on the grounds by 11:00 AM. There will be strict enforcement of the 4 hour Lasix administration rule. The Lasix fee is \$35.

All horses (including ponies) shipping to Monmouth from outside the State of New Jersey are required to have health certificates issued within a ten day period immediately preceding the date of arrival.

Monmouth Shoe Rule - Queens Plates or Queens Plates XT only. This will be strictly enforced.

The races will be started by NSA Starter, Rug Howard. Course configuration - 2 jumps on frontside, 2 jumps on backside, first fence in stretch will be jumped the last time. Total fences - 9.

All jockeys are required to use the "Pro Cush" whip. Jockeys are reminded that New Jersey rules allow only 5 lbs. of overweight.

Purses will be distributed by the NSA as follows: 60% to first; 18% to second; 10% to third; 5% to fourth; 4% to fifth; and 3% to sixth. An administrative fee equivalent to 2% of the purse will be retained by the NSA from owners whose horses earn a portion of the purse. Runners reward applies, with all fees waived for any horse which runs and does not earn a portion of the purse.
