Attention Jockeys: There will be a mandatory meeting between the Stewards and all jockeys at 12:15 p.m. at the jockeys' tent. There will be an officials' meeting at 12:30 p.m. at the Stewards Stand.

There will be a mandatory pre-race veterinarian exam with Dr. Donovan Dagner. Bandages are not permitted during the examination. LASIX HORSES MUST BE ON THE GROUNDS 4 HOURS PRIOR TO POST TIME FOR THEIR SCHEDULED RACE. ALL HORSES MUST BE ON THE GROUNDS 2 HOURS PRIOR TO POST TIME FOR THE FIRST RACE UNLESS EXCUSED BY THE STEWARDS FOR EXTENUATING CIRCUMSTANCES.

THIRD PARTY FUROSEMIDE (SALIX) ADMINISTRATION

Horsemen are reminded that third party administration of furosemide (Salix) is in effect at this race meet. Please refer to the 2019 NSA Fall Condition Book (center blue section) for complete details of the NSA Medication policy. Contact Dr. Jeff Witwer (803-243-0328).

Foal papers are not required to be on file with the Horse Identifier at the races providing the horse can be properly identified; and tattoos or microchips are required for all horses, with a one-time exception providing the horse can be identified by its markings. All scratches must be made no later than one hour prior to post time for the first race.

Attention Trainers: The weather forecast for the 29th is hot and dry, high 90. Foxfield is not equipped electrically for fans. If trainers are bringing fans for their horses they will need to provide generators.

As required by the Virginia Department of Agriculture: All horses (including horses originating within Virginia) entering Foxfield Races must have an official health certificate dated within 30 days of entry and signed by a licensed veterinarian. This document must contain the following statement: "Horses represented on this certificate have not originated from a barn with a confirmed or suspected case of Equine Herpes Virus or Strangles, have not shown signs suggestive of these diseases, and have not been febrile within the previous three weeks". Rectal temperature for each horse at the time of examination must be recorded on the health certificate. Coggins test must be conducted within 12 months, and the test report must be presented with the health certificate. The test must be valid to cover the time the horse is expected to be within the facility.

All owners, trainers, and riders should enter at the East Gate (the gate closest to Charlottesville). We will be following a new procedure this year because of the problem with counterfeit tickets. All OTR's must have the proper credentials and hang tags. Credentials will be located at the barn area in the hands of Jimmie Jack Marks. They will receive an OTR ribbon which will give them access to the tower area. They will also receive a parking hang tag with the directions to the parking spot. Horsemen should use alternate routes rather than Garth Road to avoid being stuck in traffic! All horsemen are invited to lunch at the tower beginning at 11:00 a.m.

Following the races the road will be closed to through traffic. Those people who exit from the East Gate must turn right and travel towards Charlottesville.

The Foxfield race course was inspected on September 17, 2019 by Thomas Shifflett.

Turf: The turf is at 4.5 inches and fairly consistent.

Smoothness: The course is smooth throughout.

Compaction: 12.5 (good to firm)

Moisture: 3 (average dry)

Notes: We have not had much rain. The course has been aerated but we need some rain.
