ATTENTION JOCKEYS: There will be a mandatory meeting of jockeys with the Stewards at the jockeys quarters following the Officials Meeting, at 11:30 a.m. All jockeys are reminded to check in with the Clerk of Scales one hour prior to post time of the first race and report his/her engagement(s) and overweight, if any. JOCKEYS MAY NOT WEAR ADVERTISING ON THEIR BRITCHES. NOTE: Smoking and/or vaping is prohibited in the barn area and jockeys quarters. Riders are restricted to the Jockeys Quarters and Saddling Paddock area until after their last mount.

Pre-Race Exams & Lasix Information: Mandatory pre-race exams will begin at 8:30 am. Bandages are not permitted during the examination. ALL HORSES MUST BE ON THE GROUNDS BY 10:30 A.M. REGARDLESS OF LASIX TIME. If your horse's Lasix time is earlier than 10:30 A.M. it must be on the grounds 4 hours prior to post time of their scheduled race.

THIRD PARTY FUROSEMIDE (SALIX) ADMINISTRATION: Horsemen are reminded that third party administration of furosemide is in effect at this race meet. See Schedule. If your horse(s) have not previously run on Lasix, a NJRC declaration form MUST BE SUBMITTED PRIOR TO ENTRY. These forms can be faxed to 732-462-9894. If you have ANY question about whether your horse is eligible to run on Lasix, please call or text the NJRC Lasix verifier, Debbie George, at 732-513-9942. Lasix administration will be conducted by Dr. Celeste Kunz (908-875-5075). Minimum Lasix dose is 3cc, maximum dose is 10cc.

ALL HORSES MUST BE TATTOOED or MICROCHIPPED with the approval of the Stewards. No raised toes, front or rear, will be permitted in any race. A raised toe is defined as an extension of the shoe by more than 1/16 of an inch. Stickers, caulks and turndowns are not permitted. Shoes will be inspected before each race.

All horses will be saddled in the Stable Saddling Paddock located near the stables. All saddlecloths will be distributed at the time of saddling on a race by race basis. You will not be able to pick up your saddle cloths in advance. Grooms will also pick up their number pinneys at this time. ALL HORSES MUST BE SADDLED AT THE STABLE SADDLING TENT IN THE STALL NUMBER CORRESPONDING TO THEIR SADDLE CLOTH NUMBER. ASSEMBLE IN NUMERICAL ORDER IN THE STABLE SADDLING AREA PADDOCK PRIOR TO EACH RACE AND PROCEED TO THE TOWER PADDOCK AS A GROUP. TRAINERS MUST ADHERE TO THE SCHEDULE THAT WILL BE POSTED IN THE BARN AREA.

Course Update: The Far Hills race course was inspected on October 14, 2019 by Dean Torsilieri and Rug Howard.

Turf: The entire turf course at Moorland Farm was aerated, slice seeded, and sand top dressed immediately after the Far Hills Race Meeting Association's Fall 2018 meet. Spring 2019 operations included divot repair, fertilization, rolling and aeration. Weekly mowing, weed control, and an aggressive IPM program have continued to keep the quality and consistency of the turf at the highest possible level. The turf is thick, lush, and has a clipped top out height of 6-8 inches. The permanent timber fences have been removed with the disturbed areas restored to turf.

Smoothness: The course has been rolled, aerated, and hand walked with root zone mix to fill any divots or cupping. The surface is smooth and consistent with a giving yet firm resiliency. There is NO vehicular traffic allowed on the course at any time.

Compaction: Readings taken with a Lang Penetrometer 100-125 (average) to 111 (good)

Moisture: Average 4-8.5 (average dry to average wet)

Notes: Supplemental watering has been required with the course receiving on average 1 inch of irrigated coverage. Rain is expected on Wednesday, October 16. This rain is not expected to have any effect on the condition of the course.

Licensing: All Owners, Trainers, Assistant Trainers, Jockeys and Grooms participating in the Far Hills Race Meeting are required to be licensed by the New Jersey Racing Commission (NJRC). Horsemen who ran at Monmouth Park in July of 2019 should already be licensed.

The easiest way to obtain a license is by going to the Commission's website at <https://www.nj.gov/oag/racing/> and click on "Licensing Forms" on the left-hand side. **There is no longer reciprocity for grooms licensed in other jurisdictions.** Please complete your forms in advance of your arrival at Far Hills. This will expedite the process on race day. New Jersey Racing Commission will have a licensing tent located in the barn area on Saturday morning. The licensing area will be staffed by 8:30 a.m. Payment can be by cash or check. If using checks, have two separate checks for licensing and fingerprints. Checks should be made payable to the New Jersey Racing Commission. License fees: Owner \$50, Stable Name \$50, Trainer \$50, Multiple Ownership \$50, Groom \$5, Fingerprinting \$36.
