The first Van entrance is just past the EMT check point that is for horses stabled in the temporary stalls. Trainers that have horses there can park there. The second entrance for Vans is the regular one we always use that's for horses stabled in the permanent barns. Those trainers should park down below the Fred Barn, same as always. NO cars are allowed in that Van area.

IMPORTANT: No cars to park in van area. All cars are to park in designated trainer/rider parking only. If cars are parked in the Van parking area they will be towed out immediately.

ALL HORSES WILL BE SADDLED IN THE BARN BEFORE EVERY RACE. THERE WILL BE NO SADDLING IN THE PADDOCK.

Foal papers are no longer required to be on file with the Horse Identifier at the races in claiming races providing the horse can be properly identified; and tattoo and/or microchip is required for all horses, with a one-time exception providing the horse can be identified by its markings.

All race day scratches must be made no later than one hour prior to post time for the first race.

Horsemen: As required by the Virginia Department of Agriculture: "All horses must be accompanied by a report of an official negative test for equine infectious anemia (Coggins Test) conducted within the last 12 months. The Certificate must accompany all horses in order to gain access to the races. This requirement will be strictly enforced. Please turn in a copy of your Coggins test to the HORSE IDENTIFIER (Brian Jarvis).

Schooling will not be permitted before, during, or after the races.

The Middleburg Spring race course was inspected on June 1, 2020 by Doug Fout.

Turf: Consists of tall fescue.

Smoothness: The course is smooth throughout. It was rolled and chain harrowed after the 2019 fall races, and aerated mid-November.

Compaction: 80 to 107 (soft to good)

Moisture: 5-6 (average)

Notes: It has been a very wet spring; the course will be mowed ten days before the races. There is plenty of thick turf throughout the race course.

JOCKEYS PROTOCOL

1. When you arrive at 9:00 a.m., your allotted time slot, at the first check point you will hand in your Health Screening Questionnaire – these **MUST** be completed prior to arrival. There will be **NO** questionnaires on site so if you have forgotten yours, **NO ENTRY. NO EXCEPTIONS.**
2. Your temperature will then be taken, you will be given a wrist band which must be put on your wrist immediately and worn throughout the day until you exit the grounds.
3. **ALL** jockeys will park on the Hillside above the Jockeys Tent.
4. When you arrive at the Jockeys Tent, you will see 7x7 painted squares with a chair. You must stay in your designated spot. **FEMALE** jockeys will go into the regular Jockeys Building and will follow the same procedure.

MASKS MUST BE WORN AT ALL TIMES

5. There will be a **MANDATORY** Jockeys meeting at 11.30 a.m. in the paddock. There will be orange cones 7 feet apart – **YOU ARE EACH REQUIRED TO STAND AT A CONE.** You **MUST** be on time for this meeting. **IF YOU MISS IT, YOU WILL BE SCRATCHED.**
6. Riders are **NOT** allowed in the stabling area so your trainer will have someone meet you to get your tack.
7. When the call for **RIDERS UP** is announced, you will come out, still wearing your mask, get straight on your horse and then go directly out onto the race course. At this point, the mask can be pulled down. **THERE WILL BE NO STANDING AROUND THE PADDOCK SOCIALIZING.**
8. After your race, everyone comes straight back to the paddock except for the winner. The winner will remain on the race course by the gates where you first came on and will have your picture taken.
9. Masks **MUST** be put back on before you dismount.
10. Only the first 3 finishers need to weigh out.
11. If there is a claim of foul, there will be a designated person in the paddock with a walkie talkie to contact the Stewards. You will then weigh out and Bill Hair, the Clerk of Scales, will hand you a walkie talkie so you can talk to the Stewards.
12. **WE HAVE A VERY LONG DAY AND YOUR COMPLETE AND TOTAL COOPERATION IS A MUST IN ORDER FOR THIS DAY TO RUN SMOOTHLY.**

GROOMS PROTOCOL

TRAINERS – YOU ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR PASSING THESE RULES ON TO YOUR EMPLOYEES AND MAKING SURE THEY COMPLETELY UNDERSTAND AND COMPLY. Also, the PRE-RACE MEET SCREENING QUESTIONNAIRE MUST BE PRINTED, FILLED OUT, PRESENTED AND UPON ADMISSION TO THE RACE COURSE.

1. Grooms must wear a mask at all times.
2. After your groom leaves the paddock and then turns their horse loose onto the race course, they **MUST** stand on the **OUTSIDE** rail of the race course. There will be a **RED X** every 7 feet marked on the **TOP RAIL**. They must each stand at one spot for the duration of the race. There are 16 designated spots. **IF THEY DO NOT STAND AT THESE DESIGNATED SPOTS AS REQUESTED, THEY WILL BE ASKED TO LEAVE. NO EXCEPTIONS.**
3. After the race, all horses will come back to the Paddock where groom take them and return to their stabling area.
4. The only exception is the Winner of the race. This horse will remain on the race course, the groom will hold onto their horse for the win picture in front of the gate where the horses first enter the track. Afterwards, they will proceed directly to the stabling area.

Pre-Race Meet Screening Questionnaire

Prior to entry to the Race Meet grounds, all entrants must fill out this health self-assessment questionnaire. Please fill it out the morning of the Races and be prepared to deliver it to authorities upon arrival at the gate. You will then have your temperature taken. Everyone must completely exit the vehicle while having their temperature taken. Anyone with a temperature of over 100.4 or with any "YES" answers to the questions below will not be allowed admittance under any circumstances. These procedures are mandated by the Virginia Department of Health in order to conduct this race meet. Thank you very much for your cooperation in advance.
