THIRD PARTY FUROSEMIDE (SALIX) ADMINISTRATION

Horsemen are reminded that third party administration of furosemide (Salix) is in effect at this race meet. Please refer to the NSA's website nationalsteeplechase.com for complete details of the NSA Medication policy. Contact Dr. Jeff Witwer (803-243-0328).

As required by the Virginia Department of Agriculture: All horses (including horses originating within Virginia) entering the International Gold Cup Races must have an official health certificate dated within the 30 days of entry and signed by a licensed veterinarian. The document must contain the following statement: "Horses represented on this certificate have not originated from a barn with a confirmed or suspected case of Equine Herpes Virus or Strangles, have not shown signs suggestive of these diseases, and have not been febrile within the previous three weeks". Rectal temperature for each horse at the time of examination must be recorded on the health certificate. Coggins test must be conducted within 12 months, and the test report must be presented with the health certificate. The test must be valid to cover the time the horse is expected to be within the facility.

Foal papers are not required to be on file with the Horse Identifier at the races in claiming races providing the horse can be properly identified; and tattoo and/or microchip is required for all horses, with a one-time exception providing the horse can be identified by its markings.

SADDLING IN THE STABLE AREA: ALL horses will be saddled in the stable area and will then be led to the paddock TOGETHER. The trainer or their designate will be responsible for transporting the tack after weighing out back to the barn for saddling. Jockeys are not allowed in the stabling area. Please note post time for each race and have your horse ready to parade to the paddock at the appropriate time. If trainers have multiple horses in a race or horses in back to back races, please make appropriate plans as it is imperative that we stay on schedule.

STABLING: Stalls will be provided for each entry. For special accommodations and bedding contact Thomas C. Williams (Reggie) at 703-843-6385. Please contact him if you plan to bring an AE horse.

NOTE TO TRAINERS: If you intend to bring a horse on the also eligible list please notify us in advance (Reggie Williams 703-843-6385).

NO SCHOOLING ON THE COURSE RACE WEEK. The course will be available for walking on Thursday, October 22.

COVID-19 Protocols:

MASKS ARE REQUIRED AT ALL TIMES while on the grounds of Great Meadow, except when jockeys are mounted on a horse.

Trainers must submit the names of owners and grooms prior to race day.

Only owners with horses running at the International Gold Cup are permitted with NSA badge and their names MUST BE SUBMITTED BY THEIR TRAINER BY WEDNESDAY, OCTOBER 21, 2020.

Signed medical questionnaire is required to be turned in upon entry to the grounds that morning by all occupants of the vehicle. If ANYONE in the vehicle has a temperature of 99.5* or higher, the vehicle and all occupants will be held for ten (10) minutes for a temperature recheck. Upon recheck, if anyone in the vehicle has a temperature of 99.5* or higher, the vehicle and all occupants will be refused entry.
