5. **We are only using the horsemen's gate on RT 926. No passes or credentials will be sent. Please send list of names of everybody who is coming with you, Trainer, Rider, Grooms and Owners. Your name must be on the list of attendees. The Health Officials will check the list, prior to temperature scan and screening questions.**
6. You will then proceed to the COVID screening station – HAVE YOUR CELL PHONE READY FOR THE QR CODE. Once the code is scanned you will complete the COVID/Contact Tracing questionnaire and your temperature will be taken. This will be performed by medical personnel.
7. SOTA Representative: Kathy Neilson (484-883-8094). The SJAA Representative will be Jennifer Webster (240-215-5486) . Please direct all horsemen's issues or these individuals prior to approaching the Race Chairman or a member of the Race Committee.
8. ATTENTION JOCKEYS: There will be a mandatory meeting of **apprentice jockeys with the Stewards at 11:45 a.m.** followed by a meeting of **all jockeys at 12:00** at the Stewards Stand. **ALL RIDERS MUST ATTEND.** All jockeys are reminded to check-in with the Clerk of Scales one hour prior to post time for the first race and report his/her engagement(s) and overweight, if any. NOTE: Smoking and/or vaping is prohibited in the stable tent area.
9. There will be an **officials meeting** at the **Stewards Stand at 12:15 p.m.**
10. There will be a mandatory pre-race veterinarian exam beginning at 9:00 a.m. with Dr. Kathy Anderson, Dr. Charles Arensberg, and Dr. Bernadette Loomis-Smith. Smoothness: The course is smooth on the Plumsted side and rougher on the former Weymouth property.

Compaction: 80-100 (yielding) The footing is good.

Moisture: In general moisture between 8-10 (average wet to wet). There is one small low area on the former Weymouth property which showed more moisture.

Notes: We had 2" of rain last week and one day of rain in the forecast for the week leading up to the races.

1. When you arrive at 10:30 am at the first checkpoint your name will be checked off the list – **IF YOU ARE NOT ON THE LIST YOU WILL NOT BE ADMITTED TO THE GROUNDS.**
2. You will then proceed to the COVID screening station – **HAVE YOUR CELL PHONE READY FOR THE QR CODE.** Once the code is scanned you will complete the COVID/Contact Tracing questionnaire and your temperature will be taken. This will be performed by medical personnel.
3. As mandated per the state and county, Riders may have no more than themselves in their vehicle unless carpooling with other participating horsemen (whose names must also be on the list such as riders and/or trainers.)

2. **THIRD PARTY FUROSEMIDE (SALIX) ADMINISTRATION:** Horsemen are reminded that third party administration of furosemide (Salix) is in effect at this race meet. Please refer to the 2020 NSA Medication Guidelines for complete details of the NSA Medication policy. Contact Dr. Taryn Gassert (610-207-9209).
3. Lasix horses must be on the grounds at least 4.0 hours prior to post time of their scheduled race.
