Meeting area will be marked with orange cones indicating where to stand in order to provide adequate social distancing. Facemasks must be worn at all times. THIRD PARTY FUROSEMIDE (SALIX) ADMINISTRATION

Horsemen are reminded that third party administration of furosemide (Salix) is in effect at this race meet. Please refer to the NSA website (nationalsteeplechase.com) for complete details of the NSA Medication policy. Contact Dr. Charles Arensberg (859-494-0841).

Foal papers will no longer be required to be on file with the Horse Identifier at the races; and tattoos or microchips are required for all horses, with a one-time exception providing the horse can be identified by his/her markings. All scratches must be made no later than one hour prior to post time for the first race.

Attention Horsemen: There will be a mandatory pre-race veterinarian exam with Dr. Charles Arensberg. LASIX HORSES MUST BE ON THE GROUNDS 4 HOURS PRIOR TO POST TIME FOR THEIR SCHEDULED RACE. ALL HORSES MUST BE ON THE GROUNDS 2 HOURS PRIOR TO POST TIME FOR THE FIRST RACE UNLESS EXCUSED BY THE STEWARDS FOR EXTENUATING CIRCUMSTANCES.

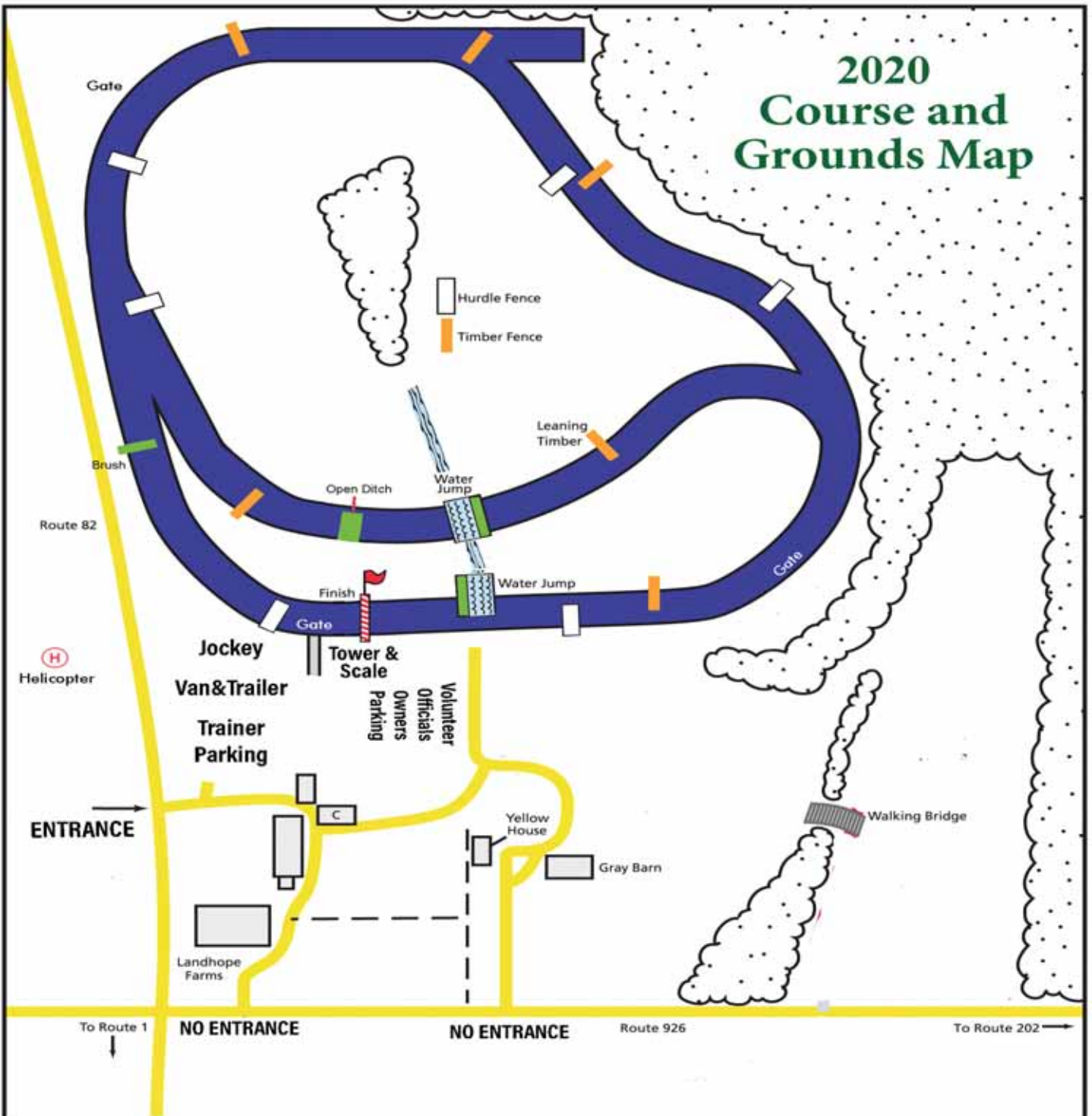
