EXTENUATING CIRCUMSTANCES.

THIRD PARTY FUROSEMIDE (SALIX) ADMINISTRATION; Horsemen are reminded that third party administration of furosemide (Salix) is in effect at this race meet. Please refer to the NSA's website nationalsteeplechase.com for complete details of the NSA Medication policy. Contact Dr. Jeff Witwer (803-243-0328). ALL LASIX HORSES MUST BE ON THE GROUNDS NO LATER THAN 4 HOURS PRIOR TO POST TIME FOR THEIR RACE. HOWEVER, ALL HORSES MUST BE ON THE GROUNDS NO LATER THAN 10:00 A.M. FOR THE PRE-RACE VETERINARY EXAMS.

Attention Horsemen: All scratches must be made no later than one hour prior to post time for the first race.

REMINDER: Foal papers are not required to be on file with the Horse Identifier at the races; and tattoos or microchips are required for all horses with a one-time exception provided the horse can be identified by its markings.

Attention Trainers: By order of the South Carolina State Veterinarian, all racehorses, ponies, donkeys and any other horses entering the Steeplechase of Charleston must have the following documents: Requirements for out of state horses: 1. CVI - Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (valid for 30 days) including description, date of negative EIA (Coggins) results, Lab and Accession number; and 2. Negative EIA (Coggins) test within 12 months Requirements for in-state (South Carolina) horses: 1. Negative EIA (Coggins) test within 12 months These documents may be checked by State Inspectors on race day.

RACE DAY TRAFFIC:

Heavy traffic is to be expected on race day, please be advised to new traffic pattern and parking. PLEASE PARK IN THE IN-FIELD STAFF PARKING LOT ONLY (use Gate 3). NO CARS WILL BE ALLOWED IN STABLE AREA.

All persons OTR and NSA Officials must have their parking passes scanned upon entering Gate 3.

GUESTS/NON-PARTICIPATING HORSEMEN:

Due to COVID-19 protocols, Race Officials will not be allowed to bring guests.

All non-participating Horsemen will need to purchase a Tailgate Spot in order to enter the grounds. There is no GA Tickets due to COVID-19 restrictions.

SAFTEY/COVID-19 PROTOCOLS:

All persons on the race grounds are required to wear a facemask and maintain six feet of space from other individuals not a part of their own household. Please refrain from all physical contact.

All NSA and OTR members will be provided a boxed lunch and a bottle of water. No food is to be sold on site. Therefore, if you anticipate having additional needs during race day, please pack a cooler with your necessities.

There will be NO FOOD VENDORS on site.

Our guests are being similarly impacted by COVID safety precautions, and as a result will be required to wear masks, physically distance, and provide their own food and beverages.

The event will feature double the number of sanitation stations and restroom facilities available last year, each of which will be cleaned regularly.

Race organizers have hired special safety ambassadors and additional security to gently enforce safety guidelines.

A staffed medical tent will be available to any attendee in need of help, including those beset on site by symptoms potentially related to COVID-19. An isolation tent will be available for any individuals experiencing symptoms on race day.

HORSEMEN PLEASE NOTE: There will be no temporary stabling. Horses will run off the vans. Overnight stabling can be arranged at the Springdale Racecourse for Saturday, November 14 and Sunday, November 15. Contact Jeff Teter at 803 243 0529

Trainers must contact the NSA with names of all grooms and owners who will be site on race day no later than noon on Tuesday, November 10th. This is a South Carolina state COVID-19 requirement.

The Steeplechase of Charleston race course was inspected on November 1, 2020 by Steve Spencer and Toby Edwards.

Turf: Mixture of Bermuda and other native grasses.

Smoothness: Smooth

Compaction: 90-110 (yielding to good)

Moisture: 4-6 (average dry to average)

Notes: The course received 1/2 inch of rain on Saturday night. Periods rain are forecast over the next 14 days. There are some thin areas around the turn into the backstretch and again at the turn out of the backstretch. The course has been harrowed and rolled numerous times since the 2019 races and was last core aerated the week of October 19. Grass has been mowed to 4/5 inch in height.
