Foal papers are not required to be on file with the Horse Identifier at the races providing the horse can be properly identified, and tattoos or microchips are required for all horses with a one-time exception providing the horse can be identified by his/her markings.

Attention Horsemen:

Horsemen must call J.W.Y. Martin Jr. 410-370-1144 by 6 pm, Thursday, April 22 to request stalls.

All entries must be at Worthington Farms barns and checked in with Stable Manager Jake Chalfin by 1:30 p.m. and remain until paddock call.

All scratches must be made no later than forty-five (45) minutes prior to post time for the Maryland Hunt Cup.

Fines will be imposed.

There will be a Mandatory pre-race veterinary examination for all entries at 2:00 pm at the Worthington Farms barns by Dr. Rachel Westertund and Dr. Cooper Williams. NSA protocol will be followed. NO BANDAGES of any kind will be permitted for this exam.

There will be an Officials meeting at the Steward's Tower at 3:00 pm.

There will be a mandatory Riders meeting with the Stewards at the paddock at 3:15 p.m.

All entries shall tack at Worthington Farms

Outriders and entries leave Worthington Farms barn for paddock at 3:20 pm.

No lead ponies are allowed in paddock.

All horses must be in paddock by 3:35 pm.

As a convenience to Riders, the Stewards Advisory Committee has instructed the Clerks of Scales to account for a 2 lb allowance for the safety vest upon weighing out. Therefore, all Riders must weigh out at 2 lbs. over their assigned weight, with their safety vest.

Starting at 1:45 pm, there will be a shuttle for Riders between the paddock and the Worthington Farms barn.

In keeping with the 127-year tradition of no commercial activity at our meet, the Maryland Hunt Cup will not permit any type of advertising on a Rider or a horse running in this race.

Due to Covid, there will not be a viewing of the race replay.

No dogs will be permitted on the Maryland Hunt Cup course on race day, nor will they be permitted in the stabling area at Worthington Farms. Please leave your dogs at home.

Traffic Pattern Alert

There will be NO through traffic on Tufton Avenue after 2:00 p.m. All Patron and Subscriber pass holders must access their lots from the West/ Greenspring Avenue side. At 3:00 pm the police will close all entrances to the course and Tufton Avenue.

NSA hang tags will NOT admit cars due to Covid. Any passes must be obtained prior to race day. No sales will be made on race day. No General Parking. Limited spectators. No walk-ins or drop-offs, Parking pass required for entry.

2021 Covid Requirements

A face-covering must be worn at all times, except when eating or drinking at your vehicle. All jockeys are required to wear face-coverings at all times, except when mounted and on the course. Only horsemen and necessary officials are permitted in the stabling area. Horsemen are responsible for maintaining proper social distancing throughout the day. This includes areas around the barns and trailers. If you are feeling sick or believe you have come in contact with someone with COVID-19, PLEASE STAY HOME. ALL ATTENDEES AND RACE PARTICIPANTS WAIVE ANY AND ALL CLAIMS AGAINST THE MARYLAND HUNT CUP ASSOCIATION, INC., ITS COMMITTEES AND VOLUNTEERS AND ALL PROPERTY OWNERS, INCLUDING THOSE RELATED TO COVID-19.

Paddock Notes:

Horsemen Section - only Participating Horsemen and certain Officials will be allowed in this section. Wristbands will be provided to Participating Horsemen and those Officials. No one else will be permitted in the paddock and there will not be a subscriber section in 2021 due to Covid. FACECOVERINGS MUST BE WORN PROPERLY BY EVERYONE IN THE PADDOCK.

After all Riders are mounted, entries are to be led in numerical order out of the Paddock to the Finish line. Riders may remove their face-coverings when they have left the paddock. The Post Parade will proceed from the Finish line, up the stretch and towards the last fence. There will be a gap prior to the last fence to exit the stretch.

Course Update: The Maryland Hunt Cup race course was reinspected by Liz McKnight, Nancy Roberts & Shockey Gillet on April 16.

The race is run over fair hunting country.

Turf: The turf is excellent throughout.

Smoothness: The course has been Cambridge rolled twice and the stretch will be aerated before the race.

Compaction: Range of 70-140 (deep to firm) with an average of 100 (soft)

Moisture: Range of 9-10 (wet) with an average of 10 (wet)

Notes: Overall, the course is in excellent condition. It was mowed on April 15 and will be mowed again before the race.

A bucket of flags will be available race week at the first road crossing for course walkers to mark any issues.
