ATTENTION JOCKEYS: There will be a meeting with the Stewards at 11:45 a.m. at the Jockey's Tent. ALL RIDERS MUST ATTEND. All jockeys are reminded to check-in with the Clerk of Scales one hour prior to post time for the first race and report his/her engagement(s) and overweight, if any.

There will be an officials meeting at 12:00 p.m. at the Stewards Stand.

There will be a mandatory veterinarian exam before the races. ALL HORSES NOT ON LASIX MUST BE ON THE GROUNDS 2 HOURS PRIOR TO POST TIME FOR THE FIRST RACE FOR THE PRE-RACE VET CHECK UNLESS EXCUSED BY THE STEWARDS FOR EXTENUATING CIRCUMSTANCES. LASIX HORSES MUST BE ON THE GROUNDS 4 HOURS PRIOR TO POST TIME FOR THEIR SCHEDULED RACE.

THIRD PARTY FUROSEMIDE (SALIX) ADMINISTRATION

Horsemen are reminded that third party administration of furosemide (Salix) is in effect at this race meet. Please refer to the NSA website (nationalsteepchase.com) for complete details of the NSA Medication policy. Contact Dr. Jeff Witwer (803-243-0328).

IMPORTANT: No cars to park in van area. All cars are to park in designated owner/trainer/rider parking only. If cars are parked in the Van parking area they will be towed out immediately.

ALL HORSES WILL BE SADDLED IN THE BARN BEFORE EVERY RACE. THERE WILL BE NO SADDLING IN THE PADDOCK.

Foal papers are no longer required to be on file with the Horse Identifier at the races, providing the horse can be properly identified; and tattoo and/or microchip is required for all horses, with a one-time exception providing the horse can be identified by its markings.

All scratches must be made no later than one hour prior to post time for the first race.

Horsemen: As required by the Virginia Department of Agriculture: "All horses must be accompanied by a report of an official negative test for equine infectious anemia (Coggins Test) conducted within the last 12 months. The Certificate must accompany all horses in order to gain access to the races. This requirement will be strictly enforced. Please turn in a copy of your Coggins test to the HORSE IDENTIFIER (Brian Jarvis).

Moisture: 5-6 (average)

Notes: It has been a wet spring. The course will be mowed ten days before the race meet. There is plenty of thick turf throughout the course.
