OFFICIALS: There will be an officials' meeting at 11:30 p.m. at the Stewards Stand.

THIRD PARTY FUROSEMIDE (SALIX) ADMINISTRATION

Horsemen are reminded that third party administration of furosemide (Salix) is in effect at this race meet. Please refer to the NSA's website nationalsteeplechase.com for complete details of the NSA Medication policy. Contact Dr. Nicole Swinehart (803-427-4053).

There will be a pre-race veterinary exam performed by Dr. Matt Storey beginning at 9:30 a.m. in the barn area. Bandages are not permitted during the examination. LASIX HORSES MUST BE ON THE GROUNDS 4 HOURS PRIOR TO POST TIME FOR THEIR SCHEDULED RACE. ALL HORSES MUST BE ON THE GROUNDS 2 HOURS PRIOR TO POST TIME FOR THE FIRST RACE UNLESS EXCUSED BY THE STEWARDS FOR EXTENUATING CIRCUMSTANCES.

Horsemen are reminded to bring a copy of their horse(s) Coggins test to the races.

Foal papers are no longer required to be on file with the Horse Identifier at the races providing the horse can be properly identified, and tattoos and/or microchips are required for all horses, with a one-time exception providing the horse can be identified by its markings.

COURSE UPDATE: The Queen's Cup racecourse was re-inspected Sunday, April 18, at 8:42 am by Bill Price, Co-Chair.

Turf: The turf is quite thick and lush in most areas of the racecourse. As mentioned in the prior report, there were a number of areas containing poa annua bluegrass, which continues to die off from heat and is quickly being replaced with fine turf fescue and perennial rye. Those areas of poa were over-seeded, fertilized and Cambridge Rolled, April 4. Race Sponsor TruGreen performed their last racecourse fert Monday (April 12). The expiring poa should not be cause for concern and will certainly not affect the safety of the horse or its rider.

Smoothness: The course is very smooth throughout after being Cambridge Rolled, Sunday, April 4, 2021.

Compaction: 110-120 (listed as HIGH END OF GOOD throughout). The racecourse was aerated with the Aerway, which has significantly reduced winter compaction. The course will be aerated again, as needed, in areas of heavy compaction.

Moisture: 7 (average). Rain never materialized as expected. Conversely, the racecourse Toro irrigation system is now up and running and the racecourse will be watered as needed leading up to race day.

Weather Forecast: Sunny and cool all week. Saturday, April 24, High 72 partly cloudy, 20% chance of rain showers.

Timber Race: The distance is as stated in the NSA Condition Book (3 miles) however one fence on the finishing stretch has been eliminated thus there will be a total of 17 fences, including the water hurdle.

The NC Governor Executive Order continues to limit outdoor mass gatherings for spectator sports. The Board of the Charlotte Steeplechase Foundation unanimously voted January 15, 2021 to conduct the 2021 Queen's Cup without spectators and run for the benefit of the Sport, the Owners and the Horsemen. This year's race will be run under strict COVID protocols and restrictions and with no spectators.

COVID Procedures & Restrictions

Race day COVID restrictions will be enforced, including temperature taking, health questions, social distancing and wearing of masks where social distancing is not possible or under tent. Periodic reminders will be made by volunteers.

- Enter through **GATE 3**, located at 3830 S. Potter Road, Monroe, NC 28112. [Click here for Google Map](#)
- Upon entry at the gate, ALL SPONSORS, GUESTS, HORSEMEN, OWNERS & OFFICIALS' names will be crossed checked, temperatures taken and recorded along with a wrist band applied to indicate a health check. Please wear your wristband at all times unless you like your temperature checked several times during the course of the day!
- PLEASE NOTE: For contact tracing purposes, the Queen's Cup will require names and phone numbers of ALL HORSEMEN (trainers, jockeys, grooms, van drivers, etc.) IN ADVANCE but no later than April 21. Please email detailed information to carrington@queenscup.org.
- Temperature readings and short form questionnaires will be performed by Race Sponsor NOVANT Health at the rear of Member's Hill for those not wearing designated health check wrist bands.
- HORSEMEN & OWNERS will observe strict social distancing with no obvious contact or congratulatory gestures with others outside of their immediate family, including winner circle presentations.
- Jockeys and Outriders must wear masks at all times **except** when on a horse.
- There will be no trophies provided this year to the winning connections. Sorry!

New Post Time / Saddling Procedure / Jockey Shuttle

- Post time for the first race is 12:30 pm with races run every 30 minutes. To facilitate timely post times, all saddling will be in the stable area.
- Runners, once saddled in the barn area, will be organized by saddle cloth number at least 15 minutes prior to each Post Time and then parade single-file to the Parade Ring.
- The Race Meet Committee has asked all horsemen to be prompt and timely to the Parade Ring and to maintain professional decorum at all times.
- Jockey shuttles will be available to and from the Jockey tent to the Stabling area for those wearing wristbands.

Owners Wishing to Attend

For the safety of all concerned, Owners are encouraged to watch the NSA's live stream production. However, Owners running horses and wishing to attend the Queen's Cup will be made available on a limited, first come - first served basis. To offset a small portion of the cost to run with limited income, a nominal, non-refundable payment of \$100 per person will be charged in advance. Owners will receive a box lunch, limited bar service along with assigned seating in a Lawn Box as well as under tent. Owners wishing to reserve one of the limited seats, please email carrington@queenscup.org no later than close of business, **April 19th**.

Participating Horsemen & Jockeys Lunch

- Participating TRAINERS and GROOMS will be provided complimentary box lunch along with bottled water, available in the stable area only.
- JOCKEYS will be provided a box lunch in the Jockey's Tent along with traditional snacks, water and Gatorade.
- PLEASE NOTE: Participating TRAINERS, GROOMS, JOCKEYS and OFFICIALS will have access to Member's Hill but will not have access to Lawn Box seating or the hospitality tent on Member's Hill, which is reserved for Sponsors, Guests and Owners.

Stall Assignments

- For 2021, the Queen's Cup is the first on the circuit and only "hurdle" Meet on the day.
- The Committee has carded 5 jump and 2 training flat races and is able to provide 64 stalls under tent and another 6 portable open roof stalls at the tree line in the stabling area to be used for entry overflow, testing, or outriders. However, stall assignments will be based on each trainer's entries with priority given to horses in jump races over training flat entries.
- PLEASE NOTE: If there is an abundance of jump entries limiting stall availability, one or both training flat races may be combined or canceled with prior notice on Wednesday, April 21.

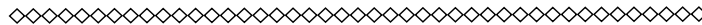
