ATTENTION JOCKEYS: There will be a mandatory meeting all jockeys at 11:30 a.m. at the jocks room. ALL RIDERS MUST ATTEND. All jockeys are reminded to check-in with the Clerk of Scales one hour prior to post time for the first race and report his/her engagement(s) and overweight, if any.

There will be an Officials' meeting at 11:45 a.m. in the paddock. All NSA Officials are to be on the grounds by 10:00 a.m. All horsemen and officials are invited to have lunch in the horsemen's tent (adjacent to the Paddock) beginning at 11:00 a.m.

There will be a pre-race vet check performed by Dr. Ronnie Fulmer and Dr. Susannah Kennedy beginning at 7:30 a.m. at the Barn C of the racecourse and ending at the race barn around 10:00 a.m. ALL HORSES NOT ON LASIX MUST BE ON THE GROUNDS 2 HOURS PRIOR TO POST TIME FOR THE FIRST RACE FOR THE PRE-RACE VET CHECK UNLESS EXCUSED BY THE STEWARDS FOR EXTENUATING CIRCUMSTANCES. LASIX HORSES MUST BE ON THE GROUNDS 4 HOURS PRIOR TO POST TIME FOR THEIR SCHEDULED RACE.

THIRD PARTY FUROSEMIDE (SALIX) ADMINISTRATION

Horsemen are reminded that third party administration of furosemide (Salix) is in effect at this race meet. Please refer to the NSA website (nationalsteeplechase.com) for complete details of the NSA Medication policy. Contact Dr. Nicole Swinehart (803-4274053).

Foal papers are not required to be on file with the Horse Identifier at the races in claiming races providing the horse can be properly identified; and tattoos or microchips are required for all horses, with a one-time exception providing the horse can be identified by the markings.

CAROLINA CUP - NOTICE TO HORSEMEN CONCERNING NEW NSA MEDICATION POLICY

All trainers running a horse on furosemide (Salix) at the Carolina Cup, that are not stabled in Barn B-1 or Barn B-2, must move their horses to Barn B-1 or Barn B-2 by the prescribed time for Salix administration (4 hours prior to post time) and vet check. Those horses will remain stabled until paddock time for their race.

Attention Trainers: By order of the South Carolina State Veterinarian, all racehorses, ponies, donkeys and any other horses entering the Springdale Race Course for the Carolina Cup Races must have the following documents:

Requirements for out-of state horses:

1. CVI - Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (valid for 30 days) including description, date of negative EIA (Coggins) results, Lab and Accession number; and
2. Negative EIA (Coggins) test within 12 months

Requirements for in-state (South Carolina) horses:

1. Negative EIA (Coggins) test within 12 months

These documents may be checked by State Inspectors on race day.

There will be no training on the racecourse or around the perimeter of the racecourse.

Attention Horsemen: Anyone wearing a Carolina Cup Horsemen's badge may use boxes I1-6 and J1-6 in the grandstand.

O/T/R's are encouraged to be on the grounds by 10:00 a.m. due to heavy traffic.

All participating owners, trainers, riders and grooms are encouraged to pick up Carolina Cup credentials from the Carolina Cup Racing Office PRIOR to 5:30 p.m. on Friday, May 21, 2021. The office will be open on Saturday from 7:00 a.m. to 10:00 a.m.

There will be a Best Turned Out "Horse and Groom" Award Presented by Jason & Nancy Ruch of Smallwood Stable. There will be a \$100 prize awarded to the winning pair per race. Hunters Trace Farm and Tribute Feed are sponsoring a cooler to go to the winning trainer of each race except for The Carolina Cup, which is sponsored by Fenwick Farms.

All post-race testing will be done in two stalls of the four-stall barn between Barn B and the Block Barn. The designated stalls face the Block Barn. Please be advised that horsemen will need to make necessary arrangements for buckets and equipment to cool their horses out in this area if being tested. No horse will be allowed to go back to any outer barns: A, C, D, E until completion of testing.

The Carolina Cup racecourse was inspected on May 10, 2021 by Jeff Teter.

Turf: The turf is a mixture of Bermuda Grass overseeded with Winter Rye.

Smoothness: The course is smooth throughout.

Compaction: 100 through 140 (good to firm) throughout the track. Average 120 (good).

Moisture: Readings: 0-2 (dry) throughout the race course.

Notes: The race course is being mowed on May 10. May or may not be mowed again. Mowing is at 3.5 inches. The course was aerated and chain harrowed back in October while being overseeded with Winter Rye. The race course was fertilized with 300 pounds to the acre with 33-0-8 fertilizer. It has been dry the last 70 days. March rain: 1.90 inches; April rain: 1.00 inch; May rain so far: 1.25 inches. There are chances of rain, May 10-12. The turf is in transition from Winter Rye to summer Bermuda Green throughout.

Update to the Course Report (May 17, 2021):

Over 3 inches of rain received since course inspection on May 10, 2021.

Moisture: 5 (average)

Compaction: 100 (soft)

Hurdle Course will be watered with a water truck through race day. Flat Course will not be watered.

DIRECTIONS:

From the North: I-95 South to I-20 West. Take Exit 98 and turn right off the exit ramp onto US 521.

Follow US 521 (Broad Street) through town and turn left onto Knights Hill Road. Springdale Race Course is approximately 1 mile on the right.

From the South: I-20 East to Exit 92 (Lugoff/Camden). Turn right off the ramp and follow Route 601 North. Merge right onto Route 1 North and follow through Lugoff over the Wateree River Bridge. Turn left onto Springdale Drive and turn right onto Knights Hill Rd. Springdale Race Course will be on the left.



Carolina Cup Racing Association Horsemen's Credentials and Luncheon Tent Tickets

1. NSA pins are considered a general admission ticket. The NSA pin will allow access to the paddock and the Grandstand, but NOT the Horsemen's Luncheon tent. NSA parking tags allow access to the Horsemen gate only.
 2. Participating horsemen may pick up their credential envelopes in the Carolina Cup office the week prior to the races Monday-Friday 9AM-4 PM. If you will not be arriving until race day, please call Jena Hough at the office (803) 432-6513 to make other arrangements for picking up credentials.
 3. Participating horsemen will receive two (2) horsemen credentials, and one (1) parking credential without charge. If more convenient, one person is allowed to pick up and sign out Owner, Trainer and Rider packets at one time.
 4. Horsemen's Luncheon tent - a complimentary luncheon tent for participating horsemen and officials is adjacent to the Paddock. Lunch will be served from 11:30-2:30. There will also be a Horsemen's Reception and Race Replay in the tent immediately following the final race.
