OFFICIAL ACTIONS:

Race I

#1 AIR LIFT pulled up before the last fence tired.

#5 BOYFRIEND BRIAN (IRE) pulled up before the last fence tired.

#6 BOOBY TRAP pulled up before the 8th fence tired.

#8 BETTER TAPIT pulled up before the 8th fence tired.

In this race #10 THE FLASCHE was claimed by Ballybristol Farm LLC, Trainer Leslie Young.

Trainer Keri Brion asked and received permission from the stewards to handle her horse at the start before entering the box as there was no assistant starter present.

Race II

#1 LAP OF THE GODS was pulled up tired before the 8th fence.

#4 TOLAGA BAY was pulled up tired before the 8th fence.

#6 CAUSE FOR PARDON fell at the 10th fence. He got in close hit the top of the fence and flipped landing on his rider Gerard Galligan who was pinned under him. Both horse and rider were examined and cleared.

#7 SHOOTIN THE BREEZE lost his rider at the 5th fence. He chipped in, hit the top of the fence and shot his rider over his head. Jockey McKenna was examined by the course physician and cleared to ride.

Race III

#1 WHISKEY CHASER pulled up tired at the 9th fence.

#2 HONOVI pulled up tired at the 10th fence.

#6 SWIM pulled up tired at the 9th fence.

Race IV

The odd numbered horses #1 SPORTSWEAR (GB), #3 THE HAPPY GIANT, #5 HEPCAT and #7 ADJUTANT (GB) were selected for pre-race cobalt testing in this race.

#2 REPEAT REPEAT pulled up before the 9th fence tired.

#4 SHOW COURT (IRE) pulled up before the 9th fence tired.
