Colonial Downs Stewards' Ruling

A report from Industrial Laboratories, the official Chemist of the National Steeplechase Association, showed the blood sample S-E345101, taken from the horse "Screen Image," who finished first in the eleventh race on Monday, August 9, 2021, tested positive for "Phenylbutazone" in the amount of 0.78 micrograms per milliliter of plasma, which is more than double the maximum permitted concentration under the ARCI controlled therapeutic substance list.

A Steward's Hearing was held on August 23, 2021. The owner-trainer of this horse Theodore C. Gregory, DOB 9/18/1951, ARCI #145700, waived his right to a split sample.

The horse "Screen Image" is hereby disqualified from all purse monies in the eleventh race on Monday, August 9, 2021. The purse is ordered redistributed as follows: 1st - Down Royal (\$45,000); 2nd - Lizzy (FR) (\$13,500); 3rd - Eve's City (\$7,500); 4th - Cainudothetwist (\$5,250); 5th - Tap Dance Star (\$1,000); 6th - Speed Alert (\$1,000); 7th - Screen Image (\$1,000).

Colonial Downs Licensing

NSA Horsemen are not required to have a VRC license for the Colonial meet. However, if horsemen would like to become licensed for the International Gold Cup, they can do so in the latter portion of the Colonial meet.

Health Certificate for Colonial Downs

A 24-hour health certificate is required to ship into Colonial Downs. Please see the Colonial Downs condition book for details.

150-Day Layoff Report Forms

Entries for horses that have not raced for 150 days or more (excluding first-time starters) will **not** be accepted unless the trainer has completed and submitted a Layoff Report Form to the Equine Medical Director or Chief Veterinarian. Forms must be submitted at least 30 days prior to entry, and are valid for 60 days. Forms should be submitted to the Racing Office, or to the email address for the appropriate racing jurisdiction. New NYRA Policy

Please note that horses aged 10 years old and upward will not be permitted to run at NYRA race-tracks. This change in policy does apply to steeplechase races.

Jockeys at Saratoga

All jockeys riding at Saratoga must be fully vaccinated a minimum of 14 days prior to arrival on NYRA grounds.
