ATTENTION JOCKEYS: There will be a mandatory meeting of all jockeys with the Stewards at 11:30 a.m. at the steward stand. ALL RIDERS MUST ATTEND AND WILL BE FINED FOR BEING LATE. Cloth saddle towels will be issued this year. Jockeys will be fined \$100 for not returning the saddle towels to the Clerk of Scales after each race. All jockeys are reminded to check-in with the Clerk of Scales one hour prior to post time for the first race and report his/her engagement(s) and overweight, if any.

After each race, jockeys are to ride back to the paddock and dismount in the paddock where they will check in with the Clerk of Scales.

ATTENTION ALL HORSEMEN: The race day program will be online only and available at www.shawandowns.com/legacychase. There will NOT be a printed program.

There will be a mandatory pre-race vet check at the stable area with Dr. Rachel Westerlund and Dr. Brooke Harper starting at 10:00 a.m. LASIX HORSES MUST BE ON THE GROUNDS 4 HOURS PRIOR TO POST TIME FOR THEIR SCHEDULED RACE. ALL HORSES MUST BE ON THE GROUNDS 2 HOURS PRIOR TO POST TIME FOR THE FIRST RACE UNLESS EXCUSED BY THE STEWARDS FOR EXTENUATING CIRCUMSTANCES.

Foal papers are not required to be on file with the Horse Identifier at the races providing the horse can be properly identified; and tattoos or microchips are required for all horses, with a one-time exception providing the horse can be identified by his/her markings. All scratches must be made no later than one hour prior to post time for the first race.

Course Report: The Shawan Downs course was inspected Monday morning, September 20 by Charles C. Fenwick, Jr. and Tara Elmore. The Update readings on Monday, September 20 were:
 Compaction: Entire Racecourse 105 (good)
 Moisture: Entire Racecourse 6.9 (average)
 Turf: The turf consists of a mixture of blue grass, native fescue & a "Kentucky 31" mix that averaged 4" in height at the time of inspection. On race day, we expect to be running over 6" of grass.
 Smoothness: The course is smooth and even.
 Notes: Since the August 31, the entire racecourse has received 5" of natural rainfall. The entire racecourse was aerated on August 30.
