ATTENTION OFFICIALS: There will be an officials meeting at the stewards stand at 12:15 p.m.

ATTENTION JOCKEYS: There will be a mandatory meeting of all jockeys with the stewards at the jockeys quarters at 12:00 p.m. All jockeys are reminded to check in with the Clerk of Scales one hour prior to post time of the first race and report his/her engagement(s) and overweight, if any. JOCKEYS MAY NOT WEAR ADVERTISING ON THEIR BRITCHES. NOTE: Smoking and/or vaping is prohibited in the barn area and jockeys quarters. Riders are restricted to the jockeys quarters and saddling paddock area until after their last mount.

The jockeys tent will be located by the saddling paddock. The Clerk of Scales will be at the saddling paddock for weighing out, and at the tower for weighing in.

Please note that the New Jersey Whip Rule applies at Far Hills. Details can be found on the Official Notices page on the NSA website.

Pre-Race Exams & Lasix Information: Mandatory pre-race exams will begin at 8:30 am. Bandages are not permitted during the examination. ALL HORSES MUST BE ON THE GROUNDS BY 10:30 A.M. REGARDLESS OF LASIX TIME. If your horse's Lasix time is earlier than 10:30 A.M. it must be on the grounds 4 hours prior to post time of their scheduled race.

THIRD PARTY FUROSEMIDE (SALIX) ADMINISTRATION: Horsemen are reminded that third party administration of furosemide is in effect at this race meet. See Schedule. If your horse(s) have not previously run on Lasix, a NJRC declaration form MUST BE SUBMITTED PRIOR TO ENTRY. If you have ANY question about whether your horse is eligible to run on Lasix, please call or text the NJRC Lasix verifier, Debbie George, at 732-513-9942. Lasix administration will be conducted by Dr. Celeste Kunz (908-875-5075). Minimum Lasix dose is 3cc, maximum dose is 10cc.

All horses will be saddled in the stable saddling paddock located near the stables. All saddlecloths will be distributed at the time of saddling on a race by race basis. You will not be able to pick up your saddlecloths in advance. Grooms will also pick up their number pinneys at this time. ALL HORSES MUST BE SADDLED AT THE STABLE SADDLING TENT IN THE STALL NUMBER CORRESPONDING TO THEIR SADDLE CLOTH NUMBER. ASSEMBLE IN NUMERICAL ORDER IN THE STABLE SADDLING AREA PADDOCK PRIOR TO EACH RACE AND PROCEED TO THE TOWER PADDOCK AS A GROUP. TRAINERS MUST ADHERE TO THE SCHEDULE THAT WILL BE POSTED IN THE BARN AREA.

All vans arriving Friday, October 18 must use Gate 2 off Route 202. Security will continuously check Gate for late arrivals.

Stabling: Bedding will be provided to horses on racecourse free of charge upon application to Natalie Gallagher (973-539-7679). Racecourse phone (908-234-9115).

BARN ACCESS IS LIMITED TO LICENSED OWNERS, TRAINERS, RIDERS, GROOMS AND ASSOCIATED TRUCKING/SHIPPING PERSONNEL WITH FHRMA BARN ACCESS WRISTBANDS. WRISTBANDS WILL BE DISTRIBUTED IN THE NJRC LICENSING TENT AT TIME OF LICENSING. IF YOU ALREADY HAVE YOUR NJRC LICENSE PLEASE STOP AT THE TENT TO PICK UP YOUR BARN ACCESS WRISTBAND. TENT OPENS AT 8:30 AM. PLEASE REMIND YOUR SHIPPER TO PICK UP A WRISTBAND AT THE LICENSING TENT. NO ONE WILL BE ALLOWED IN THE STABLE AREA WITHOUT THE BARN ACCESS WRISTBAND.

New this year - any trainer or owner who does not have his/her fingerprints on file in NJ or the Racing Compact needs to if they are running at Far Hills regardless of whether or not that person is physically at Far Hills. You can get fingerprinted at many police stations, then email or text the image to Steve Pagano, NJRC Presiding Steward (609-372-3245, spag527@yahoo.com)

**Note: All six stakes races at Far Hills are part of the Sport of Kings series. Therefore, in addition to NSA fees, 5% of any purse money earned will be deducted as a fee to the Sport of Kings Reserve Fund.**

Turf: The turf is thick and even.

Smoothness: The turf is smooth throughout.

Compaction: 85 - 95 (soft).

Moisture: 5 - 6 (average).

Notes: On the lower turn, there are some areas where is turf is thin.

**Directions:**

From Route 78: Take Exit 29 to Route 287 North to Exit 22B (Route 202/206 North). Bear right at Route 202 North and proceed to Gate #2.

From Bernardsville via Route 202 South: At railroad tracks in Far Hills, turn left onto Liberty Corner Road (county #512) to Gate #4 or Gate #5.

From the South via Route 287: Take Exit 22B. Turn right onto Route 202/206 North. Bear right onto Route 202 North and proceed to Gate #2.

From the North via Route 287: Take Exit 22 to Route 202/206 North. Bear right onto Route 202 North and proceed to Gate #2.

From Chester/Peapack Area via Route 206 South: Turn left onto Pottersville Road (County #512) to Main Street in Gladstone. Turn right onto Main Street in Gladstone (still County #512). Follow into Far Hills. Turn left onto Route 202 North and proceed to Gate #2.

From Basking Ridge & Liberty Corner via Liberty Corner Road (County #512): Proceed North on Liberty Corner Road (County #512), turn left and proceed to Gate #4 or Gate #5.

**Attention Trainers**

With the upcoming pari-mutuel race meets at Far Hills, it is imperative that all equipment and medication changes are made at the time of entry. Those changes include: blinkers, cheek pieces, hoods/masks, and Lasix. Please pay particular attention to these details when your entry is made and on race day upon review of your horse’s past performance

**Far Hills Licensing –New Jersey Racing Commission**

All Owners, Trainers, Assistant Trainers, Jockeys and Grooms participating in the Far Hills Race Meeting are required to be licensed by the New Jersey Racing Commission (NJRC). ***There is no longer reciprocity for grooms licensed in other jurisdictions.***

The easiest way to obtain a license is by going to the Commission’s website (<https://www.nj.gov/oag/racing/> ) and click on “Licensing Forms” on the left-hand side, or by clicking here - [https://www.nj.gov/lps/racing/licensing\\_forms.html](https://www.nj.gov/lps/racing/licensing_forms.html)

Please complete your forms in advance of your arrival at Far Hills. This will expedite the process on race day.

The final phase of the licensing process will be completed Saturday morning on the grounds.

**NJRC will have a licensing tent located in the barn area.** The licensing area will be staffed by 8:30 a.m.

Licensing fees are as follows:

Payments can be by cash or check. **If using checks, please have 2 separate checks for licensing and fingerprints.** Checks are to be made payable to the New Jersey Racing Commission.

**SADDLING:**

All horses will be saddled in the Saddling Paddock located near the stables. All saddle cloths will be distributed at the time of saddling on a race by race basis. You will not be able to pick up your saddle cloths in advance, as in the past. Grooms will also pick up their number pinneys at this time.

**REMINDERS:**

The Jockeys Tent will be located by the Saddling Paddock.

There will be a Clerk of Scales both at the Saddling Paddock for Weighing Out.

Weighing In will be at the Tower Clerk of Scales location.

**NEW JERSEY RACING COMMISSION PROHIBITS USE OF WHIPS:**

The New Jersey Racing Commission adopted the following prohibition on the use of whips in New Jersey for Thoroughbred racing & exercise: “jockeys will not be allowed to use the riding crop for any reason “except when necessary to control the horse for the safety of the horse or rider” & “prohibits the use of the riding crop to encourage a horse to run faster under any circumstances.”
