STEWARDS' REPORT

RACE MEETING: Foxfield Fall Races

OFFICIAL ACTIONS:

Race I

SWIM pulled up before the last fence tired.

Race II

CITE started in the training flat race, after a slight hesitation, and quickly engaged with the field, running on to a good second place finish. With this, CITE is removed from the Stewards List and may start at a pari mutual meet.

Race III

INVESTER pulled up lame after finishing second in this race. She was vanned off with a bowed tendon.

Race IV

CRITICIZE was pulled up tired before the 3rd fence from last.

JIM KEY (IRE) pulled up after the last fence and before the wire. He was vanned off with a bowed tendon.

Race V

GLOBAL FREEDOM (GB) was pulled up tired before the second last fence.

Race VI

ANIMAL KINGSTON was randomly selected by the stewards for pre-race testing.

ISMUSBEMYLUCKYDAY lost his rider, Mell Boucher, after being interfered with by SORAMOND (GER) at the second fence.

SORAMOND (GER) was rank and lugging out badly around the first turn then abruptly bolted inward across the field and through the inside wing losing jockey, Thomas Garner, who had absolutely no control of his mount.

Both riders were uninjured. They were examined by the course physician and cleared to ride. Both horses jumped the outside rail and ran down Garth Road for a distance of about three miles. They were caught and examined by the course veterinarian and appeared to have escaped serious injury.

The stewards determined that SORAMOND (GER) should be placed on the Stewards List and not be allowed to run at a race meet with pari mutuel wagering until successfully completing an NSA recognized race without wagering. Furthermore, she must school to the satisfaction of the stewards prior to her next start over fences.

OFFICIAL COMMENTS:

Riders and trainers were unanimous in their praise for the improvements to the course since our last race meet there.
